REV. FR. MAMPRE KOUZOUIAN

Father Mampre Kouzouian, the former Alexan Kouzouian, was born on the island of Cyprus in 1933. After graduating the Armenian School of Larnaca, Cyprus, he attended the Armenian Theological Seminary in Lebanon and graduated in 1954. He was the choir director and principal of the Armenian Church and School in Basrah, Iraq for two years.

In 1956 he was invited to the United States by the former Primate, the late Archbishop Mampre Calfayan, to further his theological education. For four years, Father Mampre attended the General Theological Seminary in New York City while also serving at St. Gregory's Armenian Church in New York.

He was ordained a deacon in 1957 and a priest in 1958 by the late Archbishop Mampre Calfayan.

Father Mampre was married to the former Muvart Vartanesian and they have three children.

He has been active in various Diocesan committees, and since 1965, he has been the Director of Ecumenical Affairs of our Diocese. He is a member of the General Board and General Assembly of the National Council of Churches representing the Armenian Church. Since March 1958, Father Mampre has been serving as the pastor of St. Mary's Armenian Church in Irvington, N. J.
