
Dear Mr. Kavookjian:

Apparently you have been misinformed about the addressing of the index cards. The bill you paid covered the price of cards and the operating of the addressograph. Every week to address the Zvartnotz list the church pays Mr. John Yorganjian \$5.00 for his services, which takes over three hours. It is a man's job and our secretary does not know how to do it. It was not a question of writing few hundred names. Father Arakelian was advised about this. He told our secretary to buy the large index cards, the ones our church did not have, have them addressed and that he will pay for them. No employee of the church received a penny for work done for the Cathedral Fund.
