Resolve that

the name of the Armenian General Athletic Union, Westchester Branch, Inc. be forever remembered as the founders of the Westchester Armenian Community Center and that it be properly be displayed at all times as co-owners of the Westchester Armenian Community Center, and as such have its proper place on all stationary, documents and papers of the Westchester Armenian Community Center.

Resolve that

all commitments made by the Armenian General Athletic Union, Westchester Branch, Inc. to its members and member branches be respected and so honored by the new governing body. These commitments shall include the rights as outline in the AGAU constitution, a copy of which is attached and made part of these resolutions.

Resolve that

all memorials and commmerating plagues and awards be permanently displayed at the Westchester Armenian Community Center.

Resolve that

a holding corporation be formed to govern the functions of the Westchester Armenian Community Center

Resolve that

the officers of the holding corporation shall consist of a president, a vice-president, a secretary and a treasurer, together with a board of directors consisting of as many men as will be required to properly govern the development, maintenance and programs of the Westchester Armenian Community Center

Resolve that

both uniting organizations shall elect an equal number of officers and directors to the holding corporation

Resolve that

the holding corporation Expend its efforts in the future development of the Westchester Armenian Community Center to the best interests of the Armenian Community at large.
