### Dear Syraun;

I just opened the mail and received your letter 9/13/90 in reference to the documentary scarf project for the Diocese gift shop.

### The following :

as rquested a breakdown of costs for producing a 36" square pure silk scarf hemmed and boxed as a finished product:

- D) My Fee for development of art work and procuring of all ingrdients to bring to completion this scarf and continuous
  follow through with screenmaker to make sure it is correct
  and to correct any errors, to work with printer and to go
  to printer to supervise printing and color corrections. To
  work with company who will roll hem and box scarves. To make
  certain what is delivered is as desired, to Gift shop.
- \$1,750.00
  A) Based on 300 scarves Printing and finishing.

  This will be donated by the printer. it is the single most costly item!
- A) Screens five to six colors based on six screens 1,500.00 This was to have been a donation but the screenmaker cant make a 36" engraving with his equipment. I may still find a contributor.
- A) Pure Silk fabric 350yards (necessary to order 1,900.00 50 to 100 yards extra in order to get 300 scarves You loose fabric in setting up for printing trial runs and color corrections.
- A) Roll hemming and boxing and delivery

To Ms. Syraun Pohvetzian

Taking the total costs of producing this scarf, which is not to the penny but approximate costs in some instances-because we never know what mishaps can take place! all this is built into the cost. ... Producing one scarf the cost is about \$32.00 and deducting the printing cost one scarf, cost is \$22.00 approx. You will realize at the retail price \$55.00 60.00 a profit of \$33.00 per scarf and a total of \$9,900 to \$10,000.00 on the sale of 300... scarves.

C) I will of course show you the art work and the fabric the size will be 36" square which is 1 yd square and naturally the art work will be in color.

I understand you have to think of the budget, however \$10,000.00 is a nice profit from one scarf - and as I said it could be a little more. You understand the screens are the property of the Diocese and whenever you want to have more scarves printed you can call me and I will start the wheels in action. The same follow through will be yours, for a small fee. (\$300.00)

I am anxious to get this in the mail to you..So, if there are any questions we can meet to discuss.

I reallythink this could be such a great contribution to our culture for people to learn more about us.

Waiting to hear from you....Time is fleeting!

As you know this project idea started with a letter from your sister Kohar, where she asked if I would undertake such a project.

I then tried to get in touch with you leaving messages— and — when I didnt hear from you, I proceeded to call our Primate who requested that I come and speak to him and he invited you We were interrupted by the Primate having an important call, whereupon you suggested I go to the Library and meet the learned Priest who could help with the history of Armenian artifacts...

Upon our return the Primate had to leave and thus the meeting - was never culminated. After two weeks I called you and left word that time was running out if we want this for a Christmas item.

You asked me how I saw it? I said you have to tell me your budget etc etc. Whereupon you said I should work on one scarf and think in terms of \$3000.00.


I am now working on the design, I have the pieces almost together which involves engraving, printing, hemming, boxing, also silk fabric must be ordered.


