

We pray and hope that they continue their task confidently and enthusiastically for the glory of God and for the flourishment of our community.



A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE HOLY CROSS ARMENIAN APOSTOLIC CHURC WOMEN'S GUILD

Seventy five years ago a group of dedicated ladies of the Armenian faith decided to form a group to promote their heritage and religion. They had no church, but their vision led them in the direction of commitment.

On April 9, 1916, the women met in the home of Mrs. Anosh Zarifian and organized the beginning of the Armenian Apostolic Church Ladies Aid Society of Lawrence.

The following ladies were elected as the first Executive Committee: Anoosh Zarifian, Mariam Paroonagian, Loosia Arabian, Isgoohi Azarian, Aghavni Minasian, Heghine Krikorian and Satenig Boyajian.

In March of 1917 at a general meeting the following were elected to the Executive Committee:

In 1918 new members were elected to the executive as follows: Dikranoohi Nahigian, Mariam Akmakjian. Siranoosh Hovnanian and Elmas Evlian.

The Ladies Aid Society of Lawrence grew over the years in spirit and membership. Until our church was built in 1936, our faithful held their meetings in their homes, in the Garden Street Chapel and the YWCA. This shows the kind of stamina our mothers had and never gave up in spite of obstacles and inconveniences.

Through the years, many changes have taken place. In 1969, like in 1916, a new generation of young ladies had thoughts of a Young Women's organization, where they could follow in the footsteps of their mothers.

Under the leadership of Rose V. Azarian, Lawrence saw the formation of the **Young Women's Guild.** By 1979 the Guild had a membership of 53. The two organizations continued to work side by side. During these ten years the Young Women's Guild had many successful social and money raising functions, thereby bringing their share of responsibility to our church and parish. We have given our love and service by helping out all the organizations of our church with their functions and likewise they helped our cause when called upon.

It was during this time in 1977, our church embarked on one of its most extensive project of renovation. Our needs were growing and we met the challenge. We needed rooms for our Sunday and Armenian Schools, a church office, and an office for the clergy and visiting dignitaries was much needed. Our kitchen faced a complete overhaul, expansion of the hall and new restrooms were on the agenda.

In 1979 the Young Women's Guild and the Ladies Aid Society of Lawrence became one, under the name of Holy Cross Armenian Apostolic Church Women's Guild. The purpose of the merger was seen as a bond between the two organizations to serve our church with more vigor. They say strength lies in numbers and that is true of any organization. We now number 92 strong.

It was about these trying times that we were left without a parish priest. Our structure was in the process of being renovated. All our organizations pulled together and worked night and day to keep everything running smoothly. The Guild sponsored extra functions in order to make more money to help the Parish Council to meet their debts.

We had a few visiting clergy, giving us the spiritual guidance that we needed. On this occasion, it is fitting to give our heartfelt gratitude to Rev. Father Papken Maksoudian of Greater Boston. His dedication to the Armenian Church is very evident. He came even in the most inclement weather. May God give him many years of his humble service. His presence gave us the support we needed.

On may 18, 1980, our Primate, His Eminence Archbishop Torkom Manoogian, presided over the dedication of our newly completed addition and renovation of our church complex.

In 1981 our faithful parishioners witnessed the 50th year celebration of our beautiful church. Our House of Worship is admired by everyone who visits our church. God has been good to us. He gave our predecessors the wisdom to carry out their dreams. That is why we should value our legacy and protect it zealously.

On the 53rd Anniversary of our church, in 1984, we burned our mortgage. It was a great day for our parishioners and friends. Our faithful came through again with their donations, time and energies helping in every way.

On this occasion of the 75th Anniversary of the Women's Guild, the past fifteen years, the Guild has worked diligently to help lessen the burden of the Parish Council. We participated in many projects of our church. We have had cultural, social and dinner programs and have contributed close to \$134,000.

The Women's Guild thanks everyone for their support and for sacrifices these 75 years. We wish to express our sincere appreciation to our past Chairladies, their Executives and Standing Committees who have taken the responsibility of leadership. We thank all the members and parishioners who have given their time and energies to support our Guild of which we couldn't do without. Our heartfelt thanks to all our church organizations; our church choir and its director who give us our spiritual uplift on Sunday mornings when their voices sing our beautiful hymns and tell us our church is alive; to our deacons and altar servers who assist our clergy for every occasion; and also to our Sunday and Armenian School teachers and children who give us hope for the future; and to our ACYOA members who hopefully will be our leaders of tomorrow.

To our newly organized Mens' Club, we wish them success and hope they will continue working for the good of their church. To our Parish Council whom we look up to, to preserve what our forefathers gave their lives for. Our appreciation to our delegates who for years have offered their time, attending meetings and having the interest of our church in their hearts.

Our gratitude to our community for standing behind all our organizations by supporting us morally and financially. We also thank our past and present secretaries of our church who helped with all the clerical work of our Guild.

Our respect and appreciation for our new Primate, His Eminence, Bishop Khajag Barsamian, who is making his first official visit to our community and presiding over our Women's Guild 75th Anniversary celebration.

Our thanks to all the clergy who have brought their leadership and guidance to our parish. We thank our pastor, Rev. Fr. Zenob Nalbandian for his spiritual guidance in our endeavors since his arrival in Lawrence in September of 1985.

Our thoughts go back to Rev. Fr. Vartan Avakian for his 17 years of continuous service to our parish. "Der Vartan Avakian Hall," will continue to perpetuate his memory to our new generation. May God enlighten his soul.

In conclusion, the Holy Cross Armenian Church Women's Guild is proud of its accomplishments. We have tried to achieve high Standards in our goals. The greatful Lawrence Armenians did not forget to be thankful to their adopted country, the United States, for the opportunity and privilege it had given them to revive their age-old church in this land of fredom. May God Bless us all and our church.


