Dear Ms. Mirjanian:

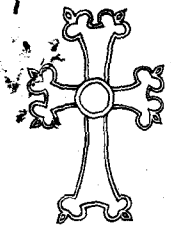

Thank you very much for your letter of 22 July 1989.

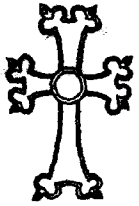
