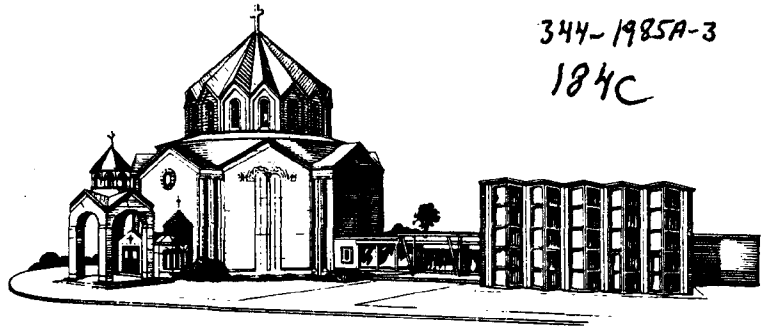

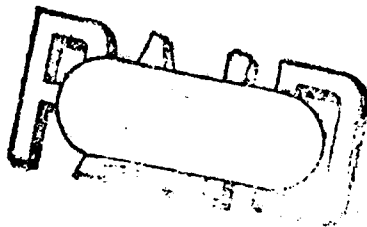
However, we will display the medal at every possible occasion to promote its sale.

At the June 25, 1985 Meeting of St. John's Parish Council, it was verbally reported by Parish Council Chairman, Arthur S. Mardigian that the Primate and the Diocesan Council feel that a period of ten months is necessary to invite and prepare for a visit of His Holiness, Vasken I, Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians for the Dedication and Opening of St. John's Museum.

St. John's Parish Council feels that ten months is too long a period of time. For this reason, at this time St. John's would like to withdraw its prior communication to you regarding the visit of His Holiness.

The last time that His Holiness visited our Diocese was in 1968. Should the Primate and the Diocesan Council choose to invite His Holiness to pay a visit to our Diocese at any time, St. John's will be overjoyed if during that visit St. John's is placed on His Holiness' itinerary of visitation.

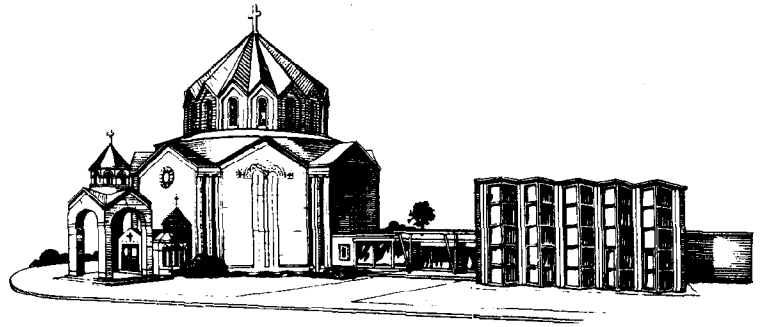
