Thanks for the checks.

With respect to the Jubilee, some accounting should also be rendered on the jubilee books that were sold. The income for these should be remitted as well, together with the income from the sale of the Primate's book of poems.

\$3,000 of the amount you remitted from the Summer Studies Program will be placed in the Etchmiadzin Fund, and the Vehapar will be informed about the gift. The remaining \$243.48 will be paid to Hagop Nazerian, after I discuss the details of the bill with him. If it proves possible to wait till you get further monies from the participants, then I shall wait.

I would like a final accounting when Richard gets back, as well as all the forms, etc., and procedures used and followed in this Program. This will form a permanent file here, and be very helpful to whoever handles the Program in the future.

Thanks for sending the books to Father Jirair.

Three weeks is OK for the Bedoukian Exhibit decision. Let me know as soon as a decision is reached.

Finally, we will handle the record matter with Father Arsen. And really a formal declaration of intent was not necessary. A note informing me of the arrangements would surely have been sufficient.

Thanks for everything.

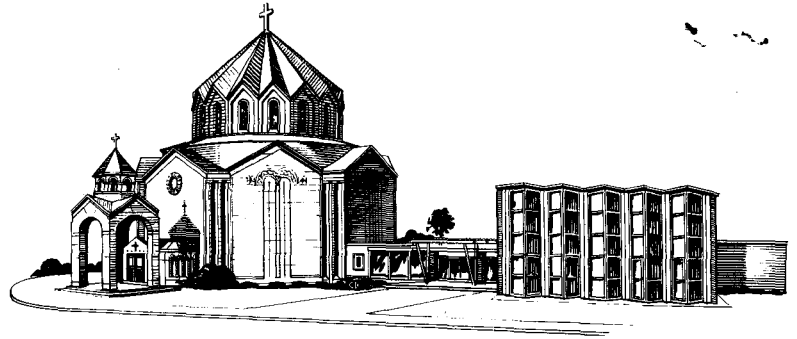

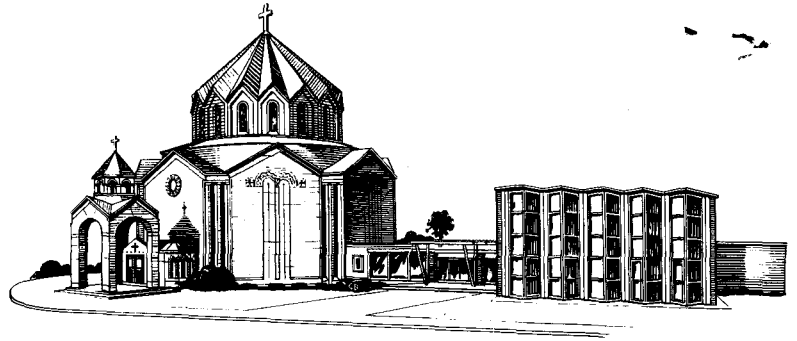
Dear Jack,

I am sending, enclosed, an accounting of the Primate's Jubilee Celebration in Detroit, and a check for \$361.00 which is the total profit from the celebration banquet. Also please find enclosed the flyers and a Program for the Celebration.

Also as you had requested I have closed the Savings account for the Armenian Studies Program and here is the total we had left in the account, \$32,433.48, which has to be transferred to Fitchmiadian account for last year and this year, as the Program's contribution to the Mother See. When Richard comes back from his vacation we will give you more proper accounting, but as you see in Mr. Nazarian's letter a total of 22 went to Armenia this year, and there have been some expenses for cancellations and late applications etc. If you could find out from Mr. Nazarian why we were charged \$51.00 for departure tax and not the participants, I think you could pay the rest of the

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bill from this amount. As I said we will give you a proper accounting label on, and also we will get the monies from the people who were responsible for the extra charges and send them to you as well. I hope this will not be a ^{cause of} great unhappiness for Hagop, I feel that it was his duty to get the monies from the kids.

Also as you had requested I am sending 25 copies of the Primate's Jubilee book and Book of Poetry to Fr. Jirair in Toronto.

As for the Bedookian Exhibit I am not in a position to give a firm answer as yet, if you could beat with me for about 3 more weeks I'll let you know. There is interest, this much I can say.

I hope everything is all right with you and at the Diocese.
