Special Parish Assembly May 22nd, 1981

A special Parish Assembly was held on Friday, May 22nd, 1981 in the Church proper. Sarkis Soultanian, Parish Council Chairman, called the meeting to order at 8:15 P. M. and Der Paree Metjian, Pastor, said an opening prayer.

Sarkis Soultanian made the opening remarks and stated that with 69 members present there was a quorum. Mr. Soultanian asked Zaven Dadekian, General Chairman of the St. Leon Community Center project, to address the parishioners.

Mr. Dadekian gave a progress report on the building and then told the members that a family had come forward and wanted to make a substantial pledge to the building fund in the amount of \$100,000. and the Building Committee felt it would be appropriate to honor this family by naming the hall after them. He, therefore, presented the following resolution:

"In recognition of an extraordinary contribution to the St. Leon Community Center Project by the Abajian Family, the Special Parish Assembly wishes to honor the family by naming the hall of the Center ABAJIAN HALL."

A discussion followed the presentation of the resolution. It was stated that the name of the hall would be placed somewhere inside the building, a place to be designated later. It was emphasized that the building will remain ST. LEON COMMUNITY CENTER, the Abajian name will only be on the hall. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Joseph Basralian reported for the construction committee: The building is 60% finished now and it should meet the schedule and be ready by August. He then answered questions from the floor.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:40 P. M. and a reception was held in the Church Hall with the entire Abajian Family present for a fellowship
