We are happy that Deacon Manoog has established himself in your parish, and feel very confident that this will be the beginning of an effective pastoral career. But the beginning of any work is always somewhat difficult, and we are relying on you and your council to bring, as we know you will, full support to his efforts. No priest can be effective, as we have often said, without the vigorous participation of the parish's lay leadership.

Some years ago the Binghamton parish, located in a relatively small community and eager to be able to afford a full-time pastor, had the happy idea of establishing a pastor's fund. The church leaders felt that it was imperative to have a full-time pastor for the welfare and natural growth of the community. But the limited resources of the small community seemed to discourage such a prospect.

To counter this circumstance, the pastor's fund was created and in a relatively short time more than \$10,000 was accumulated, at which time petition was made to the Primate for a full-time pastor. As a reserve, the fund made this possible.

The Binghamton example is one that other of our smaller parishes can follow with banefit. We urge your parish Council to give serious consideration to the idea which can be a boon for the future of your community.

Even if it takes three or four years to put together a fund that could encourage your parish to seek a full-time pastor, it will be well worth undertaking. We cannot recommend such a step too highly.

Also, we feel there is a misunderstanding regarding the stewardship program. This is in addition to your parish assessments but can be a help to your parish. For every steward enrolled in the program from your parish, the parish assessment for that year is decreased by \$100.00. In other words, to take an arbitrary figure of \$1,000 as your parish assessment and in the event that your parish has three stewards, your assessment for the year would be decreased by \$300.00, making the assessment \$700.00 instead of \$1,000. 
