ARMENIAN ARCHBISHOP TO ATTEND REGIONAL MEETING

IN CHICAGO ON OCTOBER 22

His Eminence Archbishop Torkom Manoogian, Primate of the Diocese of the Armenian Church of America, will attend the regional meeting of the midwest parishes in Chicago on Saturday, October 22. The meeting will be held at the St. Gregory The Illuminator Armenian Church, 6700 West Diversey, beginning at 11:00 a.m.

Representatives from Armenian churches in Detroit, Cleveland, Chicago, Evanston, East St. Louis, Waukegan, Greenfield, Racine, and South Milwaukee will discuss some of the many facets of the Church community, including Church Schools, Armenian Schools, choir associations, cultural programs, and youth organizations.

The Diocese of the Armenian Church of America was founded in 1898. It comprises 50 parishes in the United States and Canada. The Cathedral of the Diocese, St. Vartan, and Diocesan headquarters are located in New York City.
