Dear Mr. Antreassian:

You have received Mr. George Ingalls', Attorney, letter dated February 2, 1973, concerning the sale of the property held by the Diocese in the Town of Chenango, Broome County. You also have the terms of the sale. I have received a copy of the letter you sent to Mr. Ingalls concerning the abstract.

You no doubt are aware of the discussion I had with the Primate at the time of my donation of this property to the Diocese. Being well aware of the needs of the Diocese, and that the hope is to create a trust fund which will act as a capital fund and discussing this gift with our local parish council, it is our wish that the Diocese retain \$2500 of this sale price for the trust fund and also to retain the interest payments that are made. \$2500 of the total price other than the interest could then revert to the Binghamton parish for their capital fund.

I hope this meets with the approval of the Primate.

A number of weeks ago I sent a list of members of our parish who had subscribed to the Stewardship Program for the Diocese, and I trust that most of them have sent their donations. I have spoken to others to send theirs on. With best wishes to you and to a continued success in your work.


