Your Grace:

Enclosed is a copy of a motion that was passed by the St. Gregory of Narek Armenian Apostolic Church Parish Council at its meeting of March 28, 1988.

At the time that this motion was discussed and later passed, reference was made to page 27, paragraph "i" of the By Laws of the Diocese of the Armenian Church, (copy attached), along with the fact that our Church publication has traditionally published announcements from all our community organizations.

The Parish Council felt compelled to re-emphasize this policy by Resolution because three members of our church, two of whom are relatively new in the church community, have recently in rather vocal and sometimes insulting and disruptive ways, demanded that the occasional announcements that the local Tekeyan and AGBU chapters submit should be banned and that the PAROS should and must publish articles from Church related organizations only.

Under normal circumstances this kind of thing could be handled and laid to rest on the local level in the manner that I have just described; but unfortunately, it appears that this matter will not rest until a much higher authority lends his support to this legally passed motion in a very crystal clear manner.

D. To examine and approve, once in every year, the accounts of its subordinate bodies and to supervise and regulate their financial and administrative affairs.

E. To see to it that the church dues and all other income of the Parish are regularly collected.

F. To see to it that all expenses of the Parish, incurred in connection with religious services and other religious and educational activities and maintenance of the church, are defrayed and the purchase price and the costs of construction or repairs of all buildings and properties are paid.

G. To ensure the proper and regular performance of Church Services.

H. To establish, to supervise and to give moral and financial support to the various schools of the Parish.

I. To encourage all educational, benevolent and cultural organizations in the community.

J. To record in a special book the name and address of each member of the Church, and to keep proper records in a Register of baptisms, marriages and deaths.

K. To receive a Priest to be in charge of the Parish for the time being as ordered by the Primate until a Priest elected by the Parish Assembly can be installed.
