Your Eminence:

Your Eminence, enclosed you will find the correspondence that the Parish Council of Holy Trinity Armenian Apostolic Church of Cheltenham, PA., has asked me to direct to the Pastor and Parish Council of our sister church, St. Sahag and St. Mesrob Armenian Apostolic Church of Wynnewood, PA.

Unfortunately, over the years there have been a number of conflicts in scheduling between the two parishes. As I mentioned in my letter to Rev. Dr. Paree Metjian, Holy Trinity has always provided the entire Armenian Community of Greater Philadelphia with a schedule of events at least one year in advance. We have been willing to accommodate the other churches in this area with special preference being afforded to St. Sahag and St. Mesrob Armenian Church. For some reason the Pastor and Parish Council have chosen to ignore this accommodation.

Subsequently, some vociferous and ill inform parishioners from both parishes have capitalized upon these scheduling conflicts to create animosity between the two parishes.

A perfect example is the forthcoming celebration of Fr. Paree's 25th anniversary of ordination to Sacred Priesthood and Holy Trinity's Sunday School Graduation and Church picnic both scheduled for Sunday, June 4, 1995.

I am sure that without this letter, Your Eminence would have been wondering why I or my representative are not in attendance. Had the Pastor or Parish Council informed us on a timely bases of their plans, we would have been more than willing to change our date. As it is, no official correspondence from St. Sahag and St. Mesrob has reach this office to date. We simply have received an invitation to the banquet from a banquet committee member dated April 10, 1995.

Your Eminence, this is not the first time that such a situation has occured and the ramifications are unfortunate. I have been hesitant to address this issue, however, this forthcoming banquet has forced my hand, perhaps with my letter to the Pastor and Parish Council of St. Sahag and St. Mesrob's and by informing Your Eminence of this unfortunate situation, it will be the last time. Thank you for your consideration.

Dear Der Paree and Parish Council members:

I have been reluctant to write this letter for the past few years, however, the current situation demands that I make you aware of a problem which causes great concern for me personally and the Parish Council of your sister church.

Each year we supply you with Calendar of Events for the forth coming year. You are aware at least one year in advance of all the major events that we have planned. When we send these correspondences we always invite you to let us know of any conflicts that might occur and have always been willing to change our date when possible to accommodate your needs. Your parish has never acknowledge these correspondences.

In the past we have avoided conflict of dates with the other Armenian Churches and the Sister's Academy by making such accommodations. In some instances having parallel functions is not detrimental, example, church picnics or Palm Sunday Banquets. There are instances, where we would appreciate the attendance of your Pastor or where I, as Pastor, or my Parish Council Chairman, as representative, should be in attendance at St. Sahag and St. Mesrob Armenian Church.

The case in hand is a perfect example; on July 9, 1994 we sent you a correspondence (copy enclosed) listing the events for 1995 at Holy Trinity Church the date June 4, 1995 had been set aside for our Sunday School Graduation and Church Picnic. We heard nothing from you to the contrary. In April of 1995 to my surprise, I received correspondence from a Banquet Committee Member inviting me to a banquet in honor of Der Paree's 25th anniversary of ordination. I personally would have been honored to share in this celebration for my brother in Christ, likewise, I am confident that many of my parishioners would have been delighted to attend the Banquet on this special occasion.

Had your Parish Council written us even as late as the first of the year, we may have been able to postpone that day's activities. We have received no official correspondence from either the Pastor or the Parish Council but simply an invitation from a committee person which brings me to a second consideration. Protocol demands that when you are corresponding with the Pastor or Parish Council Chairman, letters be directed from either the Pastor or Parish Council Representative of the corresponding parish. I am constantly receiving invitation from ticket chairman, banquet chairman and/or committee members. I would appreciate in the future that you follow protocol and either the Pastor or appropriate Parish Council member direct all future correspondence.

I am saddened by the fact that I will not be able to attend the 25th anniversary of Rev. Dr. Paree Metjian's ordination to the Sacred Priesthood. I am sure you understand my parochial duties come first. I am enclosing however, a congratulatory letter on a separate sheet which I hope you have an occasion to share with the participants at the Banquet.
