Dear Parishioners:

By the Grace of God and the co-operation of our church members, we have completed another year. In Church life progress is measured by the awareness of its members of their spiritual needs. All of us are servants and have the duty in this parish to preserve the Armenian faith passing it on to our children. It gives me great pleasure to announce that the path taken by our parishioners gives us the assurance that our religious life and culture is gradually being passed on to the younger generation. I would like in a very brief form to report to you these things which I have done this past year as your pastor.

1. During the last year I offered the Divine Liturgy every Sunday taken great effort to see that services began on time. I also had special services during lent. On two occasions Divine Liturgy was celebrated by visiting Clergy, Archbishop Torkom Manougian and the Very Rev. Fr. Mesrob Dz. Semerjian.

## 2. VISITATIONS:

a. I have tried during the year to visit the sick and those who are in mourning offering them spiritual advice. Special attention was paid to visiting the various hospitals. I would like our members to keep in mind the fact that I have no way of knowing when one enters an out of town hospital, therefore, each member should keep in mind that it is necessary to inform me when someone enters the hospital. I have no other way of knowing of a persons illness and the family should not feel hurt if I failed to visit someone because I was not kept informed. I would like to stress that prayers for those ill in the hospital and also Holy Communion should play an important role in our daily lives.

## 3. SACRAMENTS

Last Year I performed the following sacraments in our parish: Baptisms 5, Weddings 8, funerals 11, adult confirmations 2, In addition to these I also performed the following sacraments in our sister parishes. Weddings 3, Funerals 6, and Baptisms 3.

## 4. MEETINGS

I have tried to be present and preside at all of the meetings of our various organizations and have been absent only when some pressing church work kept me away.

## 5. SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

During the year I attended and participated in ACYOA assembly, Clergy Conference, Diocesan Assembly, various ACYOA regional meetings and workshops. I also met with the interfaith housing committee, of which I am Vice President, various Haverhill Clergy meetings and also participated in a special memorial service for Robert Kennedy sponsored by the Haverhill ministers association. I gave a series of lectures during Lent in our church, a lecture to the Holy Trinity Women's Auxiliary and a lecture to St. James Ladies Auxiliary and I also participated in a panel discussion at Northeastern University.

## 6. PUBLICATIONS:

The church paper, Loosavorich, as well as all organization circulars and bulletins were done by me. The expenses for the paper should be offset by contributions, we urge any one who has not contributed to the paper to please do so.

## 7. ARMENIAN SCHOOL

This year we have 6 Armenian Classes, 43 students. Our teachers are: Mrs. Antranig Bedrosian, Mrs. Martin Takessian, Mrs. Sarkis Tavitian, Mrs. Hagop Kasparian, Mr Vahan Hanedanian and myself. Classes are held every saturday morning from 10:30a.m. to 12. We feel that the Armenian School is quite successful this year. A great deal of thanks should go to these dedicated teachers who give their time and ability without any monetary recompense.

## CONCLUSION

Here in a brief outline are some of the many duties I have performed during the year. There are many things left undone and certainly plenty of room for improvement in our parish. We would like to thank the church organizations, parish council and all of those who assisted us during the past year. A special thanks to our church deacons, choir leader, organists and choir and Sunday School director and teachers, Armenian School teachers, Ladies Aux. and Mr & Mrs. Club and to George Krikorian who worked so hard with the youth this past year.

Also we would like to thank all the many parishioners for their donations this past year.

A special thanks to all of our dear parishioners who co-operated and supported me during the year, and without whose help we would not have had such a successful 1968.

Pray that God may grant me, his unworthy servant. Grace that I may with wisdom and dedication, complete another year for the glory of God and his church here on earth. Amen


