The Annual Assembly of St. Gregory the Illuminator Armenian Church was called to order by the Chairman of the Parish Council, John Tatian, at 3:05 p.m. January 23, 1972. Rev. Nersés Baboorian, Pastor, gave the invocation.

Mr. Vahak Bogosian was called on to preside over the Assembly and Mrs. Zarty Chilingirian was asked to record the minutes. There were forty-two voting members present.

Mr. Bogosian, before proceeding with the meeting, read a paper explaining the purpose of assembly meetings and the importance of working in harmony and correcting previous errors. The minutes of the previous assembly were read and accepted.

Father Baboorian gave a report of his activities and duties since he came to Haverhill. One of his main accomplishments was setting up a new filing system. In his report, he referred to Mr. Paul Kazarosian as the official church lawyer. This wording was questioned by the assembly as it might create a problem in the future. It was recommended that it be noted in the minutes of the meeting that Mr. Kazarosian be commended for his many years of service to the church in a legal capacity.

Organizational reports were given by the Ladies' Aid, Armenian School, Parish Council, Sunday School, Church Choir and the Mr. and Mrs. Club.

The Auditing Committee reported the books were in order.

A copy of the financial statement as of December 31, 1971 was distributed to the members. The check book balance was \$2,231.18. The savings account at Pentucket Savings Bank showed a balance of \$11,788.99 and the reserve savings account at the Family Mutual Savings was \$703.42. Questions on the financial statement were answered by the Treasurer, Mr. Zaven Gostanian. The Auditing Committee was questioned as to whether they were thorough in their examination of the books. A suggestion was made that an auditor examine the books hereafter. The Treasurer's report was accepted.

A motion was made, seconded and passed to have the church stained windows cleaned and aluminum storm windows installed for approximately \$600.

The following were elected to serve on the Parish Council for a two year term; Edward Der Boghosian (26), Zaven Gostanian (25), Simon Hamalian (23) and Vasken Gostanian (18).

The Nominating Committee was elected as follows; Sarkis Chobanian (28), Manoog Der Boghosian (20), Edward Basmajian (20), Vahak Bogosian (16) and Leon Kasparian (14).

The following were elected to serve on the Auditing Committee for one year; Sue Kezerian (29), Zarty Chilingirian (26) and James Derderian (14).

The meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.

During the year 1971 this Board comprised of 9 members with Fr. Michael Buttero, Fr. Samourian, and Fr. Nerses Babourian in attendance at different intervals, held 19 meetings and 11 special meetings. The attendance at these meetings was almost always 100%. The members of this Board are as follows:

The major accomplishments of the Parish Council in the past year were,

Lowered the interest rate on the parish house mortgage from 8 1/4% to 7 1/2%

Increased the insurance coverage of the church from \$100,000 to \$120,000

The Annual Picnic, which was held on August 15, turned out to be very profitable and successful. Much credit should be given to Eddy DerBogossian for his time and help.

Fr. Michael Buttero was assigned to the North Philadelphia parish and his position was temporarily replaced by Fr. Samourian from Lowell.

An electric hot water heater was installed in the kitchen. Paul Tavitian donated his time and did all the electrical work on it.

The church boiler broke down and it was completely rebuilt. A major portion of the bill was covered by insurance.

On November 12 our new priest, Fr. Nerses Babourian, was honored by the members at a welcome dinner. We have enjoyed and have been very pleased with Fr. Nerses' presence ever since.

The 26th Anniversary of the church was celebrated on December 5. After an entertaining cultural program, a large amount of over \$3,000 was collected from donations.

The church was assigned 76 raffle tickets at \$25 each to help cover the diocesan deficit. This burden was taken by all the churches in the diocese.

On December 9 the members of the parish council of the three churches, Lawrence, Lowell and Haverhill, met and discussed the possibility of combining efforts and promoting more cultural affairs.

The Parish Council would like to take this opportunity to thank all the parishioners for their cooperation and support during the past year. Special thanks to Der Hair, Ladies Aid, Mr. & Mrs. Club, Choir, Youth Group, Sunday School, and Armenian School.
