ITS TOO EARLY IN THE MORNING, THEY ONLY HAVE SUNDAY TO SLEEP. TWO HOURS IS TOO LONG FOR THEM TO SIT." OR MAYBE YOU AS PARENTS FEEL YOU SHOULD NOT INFLUENCE YOUR CHILDREN, AND THE CHILD SHOULD CHOOSE THEIR OWN RELIGIOUS PREFERENCES. THESE ARE ALL EXCUSES WHICH WE BLIND OURSELVES WITH FROM THE TRUE COMMAND OF GOD; WHICH IS FROM THE BOOK OF PROVERBS AND IT SAYS "TRAIN UP A CHILD IN THE WAY HE SHOULD GO AND WHEN HE IS OLD OR OF AGE HE WILL NOT DEPART FROM IT.

Our Cunday School works, but it could work so much better with the full cooperation of all the Church Parents. We ask you to ask yourselves to please find the time in this very important time in your Childs life and come with them to Church as a Family and see to it that they attend Sunday School.
