As I understand it, the Church School was without a superintendent during 1970 until I took on this responsibility in September. Therefore, I have limited the scope of this report to the last quarter of this year, with references to future plans.

Most of the attached material should be self-explanatory, but I would like to comment on our curriculum materials. Since I was contacted too late in the year to allow time for ordering the new curriculum materials suggested by the CRE (even though they had sent no correspondence regarding this to the parish by this time), I took it upon myself to find a local outlet where I could immediately obtain suitable curriculum material. In my opinion, the material we had on hand from previous years was generally archaic as far as new teaching methods and teacher's aids were concerned.

The Nursery class is still using the old Episcopal Fellowship Series material, but the Kindergarten, Primary and Junior classes are using the newly acquired Gospel Light publications. The teachers using these materials have expressed satisfaction and consider them an improvement over their previous materials. There are Bible stories and pictures in the students' books, with Scripture references and suggestions for parents and teachers. Visual aids are plentiful to correspond with individual stories.
