COMMENTS on 1972

Weekly church attendance by the entire student body and staff has been in practice again this year. Attendance times have been rotated so as to expose the students to various parts of the Liturgy, and they have been encouraged to ask questions about what they see and hear. All attend weekly Worship Services and the Gospel is read and explained.

The Council on Religious Education of the Armenian Church provides most of the curriculum materials except for the Nursery and Second grade. The curriculum for these two grades are provided by Living Word Curriculum. <u>Armenian language</u> is incorporated, primarily in the form of word study, each week. During assembly, we talk about various subjects related to the <u>Armenian Church's beliefs</u>, and the students have become comfortable with the proper wording and behavior for the <u>Kiss of Peace and other greetings</u> in the Church.

Seven enthusiastic <u>teachers</u> and their assistants and/or substitutes teach <u>five classes</u> totaling about <u>forty students</u>. We have had great difficulty in acquiring and keeping teachers. We are also in need of a new Superintendent for the coming school year starting September 1973.
