Pastor's Report continued;

On Tuesday May 12, I was admitted to Lutheran General Hospital, in Park Ridge, where I stayed until Thursday May 21. The following Sunday May 24, I celebrated Divine Liturgy in this church. On Sunday May 31, A.C.Y.O.A members from midwest churches gathered in our church, and had a breakfast together. In the month of June, we send three of our altar servants Raffi Hazarian, Ari Tchalishkan, and Hovsep Utash to New York, to participate in a week long lecturing and training program at Saint Nersess Armenian Seminary. July 26, we had a groop of visitors comprising of 30 persons, from Gospel Center Missionary Church of South Bend, Indiana, headed by their pastor, Dr. Thomas L. Murphy. They toured the church and received concise explainations, and informations about The Armenian Apostolic Church and of Saint Gregory The Illuminator. On Monday evening of August 3, responding to their invitation Raffi Hazarian and I visited to St. Nicholas Albanian Church in Chicago, where in front of a multitude of people I red Gospel in Armenian. On Sunday Feast of Exaltation of the Holy Cross September 13, after Divine Liturgy, we gave an explanation about our standing in the church. We briefly explained the time and the places where the congregation must stand, and the time and the places where the congregation is permitted to seat. This is done in both English and Armenian Languages. September 21, I was admitted to St. Anthony Hospital of Crown Point, Indiana, for an open heart surgery, where I stayed three weeks , then I stayed home for recuperation. On Sunday November 15, I began to prticipate in Morning Services, on Sunday November 29, I celebrated Divine Liturgy. During the period of my absence, this church remained open on every sunday, with the grace of faithful and devoted deacons and choir members of ours, who within the limitations of their authority, rendered sunday services. In the month of October, Lisitzian Sisters from Armenia, visited Chicago and they sang in our church hall before a large audience. November 12-14, we had with us Rev. Father Karnig Haladjian who celebrated Divine Liturgy, during which he briefly talked about utensils and vestments used in the church, demonstrating of their usage on himself. After church services a dinner was given in the hall, followed by a brief program. On Sunday December 27, after Divine Liturgy an special service was rendered for the memory of the Protodeacon and First Martyr St. Stephen, followed by a brief reception in the hall.

In addition to the duties and works presented above; I have participated in a number of various activities, whenever my office has been called upon.
