



PASTORAL REPORT

Dear Parishioners:

Every year at our Annual Parish Assembly we gather together as servants in God's vineyard to assess the harvest of the past year and plan for the future. It is a pleasure at this time to greet all our members and review with you our past accomplishments.

BRIEF ACCOUNTS OF SOME MAJOR ACTIVITIES

During Lenten Season, every Wednesday "Hskoon" service was conducted, followed by Bible Study. Those few parishioners that took advantage, were richly blessed. We hope this year others will join.

For the first time, a month long seminar was organized for the youth of our parish. Five consecutive Mondays, senior highs participated in discussions as to what to expect when they go to college. On Monday, March 22, a panel discussion was held on a theme "What are the Real Values in Life." Young panelists were, Jack Hachikian, Norman Haboob, Richard Karamian, and Attny. Theodore Takvorian, acted as moderator. Close to 20 interested parents participated with mutual exchange of opinions. We thank Dawn Hourdajian for assisting in this worthy project.

On Sunday, June 13, Sunday School closing exercises were held in the church. Awards were presented to students with best attendance and achievement. Graduating class was asked to enroll in a two year internship program in order to receive advance certification. We are happy to say that most students are taking advantage of this arrangement.

On Sunday, June 27, 1976 High School graduates received Holy Communion. Certificates of Appreciation were presented to those who have served St. Leon as Sunday School assistants or choir members. A reception was held in their honor in our church hall.

During the week of June 28th to July 2nd, the first St. Leon Vacation Bible School was held. For five days, boys and girls, ages 8-12 years old, were involved in worship, recitation of Bible verses, arts and crafts and had the opportunity to get acquainted with our church. On Thursday, July 1, at 7:30 p. m. an open house was held with a service in the church. Close to 50 parents were in attendance.

Our heartfelt appreciation to Zabel Nalbantian, Zabel Holopigian and to all parish volunteers, who helped to make this project a success. We look forward to 1977 VBS. We hope more children will join us this year.

On Sunday, September 26, Mousa Dagh Commemoration was held. Close to 70 parishioners participated and contributed more than \$500.00 for Mousa Dagh Memorial in Armenia. Organizers: Harry Boyajian and Maritza Giragosian, would like to thank all contributors.

On Sunday, December 12, Rex Kachigian, co-chairman of Project Reach-Out introduced ten families who have joined our parish as members. Der Hayr in turn expressed his pleasure and welcomed them on behalf of the parish, offered a prayer and presented a Certificate of Membership to each family. Reception followed in our church hall in their honor giving them a chance to meet the parishioners.

CHURCH SERVICES

Divine Liturgy was held every Sunday. During all the Sundays of the year, appropriate sermons were given. All Church Services and Sacraments were conducted with solemnity and dignity. Our special thanks to Mrs. Lucy Dabagian, our Director-Organist, and Choir Members for their loyal services to God and the church. Our appreciation to the Deacons, Sub-Deacons, incensors and young acolytes, serving the Lord with zeal and dedication.

VISITATIONS

This is a very important service which is rendered by the Pastor to the best of his ability, in order to cement good relationships between the church and its members. I have blessed the homes of 55 parish members during Christmas and Easter seasons. I have also made hospital, bereavement and other pastoral calls.

I will appreciate your help by asking you to make the church office aware of all your needs in these areas.

PARISH SCHOOLS

Both Armenian and Sunday Schools began their 1976-77 academic year with a full program and new zeal. We are happy and gratified that both schools are functioning properly. We are extremely impressed with the dedication of the superintendents and teachers and the quality of their work with the children. There is no doubt that our parents will exert every effort toward the success of these sacred activities.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- . . . To date our membership is 220 voting members, 93 families and 34 individuals.
- . . . LRADOO has been published nine times, with special Christmas and Easter issues. Also special news releases were provided to local papers and the Armenian Press. Our appreciation to Mrs. Ruth Bedevian for handling our public relations with competence.
- . . . Mrs. Connie Tashjian has carried out our secretarial duties on a part-time basis. We hope to extend her responsibilities in the future.
- . . . A beautiful showcase donated by Mr. and Mrs. Sarkis
 Gabrellian in memory of their loved ones, has enhanced
 our church narthax. You may find books, records and
 religious items for sale. Last year alone, more than
 \$500.00 worth of items were sold. We thank the Gabrellians
 for their generosity.
- . . One outstanding innovation has been the labeling of our membership and general mailing list, using computerized system. Thanks to Alfred Ferraro for his time, talent and devotion to our parish. Al has also rendered many valuable services. His modesty will not allow us to reveal the nature of his contribution.

Indeed, one truly can say that 1976 has been a successful year for the Glory of God and His Kingdom. This has been possible because of the contribution of many deducated people. With heartfelt appreciation I am happy to acknowledge:

Jon Najarian, Parish Council Chairman, through his qualified leadership and cooperation, many projects were carried through. Also the 1976 Parish Council; Chairman of each church organization and their executive committees; Superintendent of Sunday School, Sarkis Bedevian and Principal of Armenian School, Hermine Menakian; Sunday and Armenian School teaching staff for their dedicated service. Last, but not least, to all active members, for their participation in making St. Leon a spiritual and growing parish.

The Regular Annual Parish Assembly was held on Sunday, February 15, 1976. The following were elected to serve a two-year term on the Parish Council: Martin Kapoian, James Noorigian, Dovie Tilbian and Vahram Varjabedian.

As you are all aware, this year for the first time we will elect an 11 member Parish Council. We hope that the increased membership of this body will spread the work load now presently carried by 9 members.

In 1976, for the first time, the responsibility for running the Bazaar was taken over by the Parish Council. In the past several years the Bazaar has grown to such proportions that it was felt the Parish Council should be directly involved in overseeing the operation of the Bazaar. The Parish Council wishes to thank all of the organizations for contributing their efforts to the Bazaar which was a tremendous social, cultural and financial success.

In 1976, a Special Parish Assembly was held at which time it was voted to purchase 1+ acres bordering our present property and to establish a negotiating committee to meet jointly with A.G.B.U. for the possibility of establishing common grounds to build a cultural center in Fair Lawn. Pending a positive direction for St. Leon/A.G.B.U. negotiations, we have held off pursuing expansion for classrooms. As a member of this committee, I can assure the Parish that St. Leon interests are always uppermost in the minds of the committee during these negotiations. A report from this committee will be given at the Parish Assembly on February 6, 1977.

We have had the usual Parish activities during the course of the year, such as the Annual Picnic in June; the Grape Blessing Picnic in August; and participation in One World Festival sponsored by the Diocese. We have had coffee socials on designated Sundays sponsored by various Church organizations, an activity we feel gives our parishioners an opportunity to meet one another. We have seen an increase in our Church attendance and additional acolytes, deacons and choir members every Sunday. We hope this continues. We would also like to see more instructional Badarak. With the help of Der Paree, the deacons and the Choir, I am sure this type of activity on designated Sundays would be beneficial to all parishioners.

Our program, Reach Out, was successful and we obtained at least ten new member families into our Parish.

The above mentioned items, such as expansion, increased activity, increased attendance, are all well and good. They show a much needed growth for this Parish, however, it must not be forgotten that all of these areas of activities require tremendous amounts of effort, not by just a few, but by all our parishioners. It is our hope that during the coming year, an expanded Parish Council will be able to enlist the support of the entire Parish because none of the endeavors such as classroom construction, joint venture with A.G.B.U., expanded Bazaar, growth of Sunday School, Armenian School and other Church organizations can be accomplished without the full support of the entire Parish.

One of the areas which is in dire need of assistance is the Sunday School. As you know, we have been earnestly looking for a superintendent to take charge of this organization. We have had to go outside the Parish to interview prospective superintendents.

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS

This year the Parish Council had the exterior of the Church and the cottage painted. This work was stopped because of weather conditions and will be resumed in the Spring when we will also paint the exterior of the parish house. New parking lot stripes and "No Parking" areas were painted on the blacktop. We ask that all parishioners observe the "No Parking" areas and the "stop lines" so designated. A dusk to dawn light was installed in the front of the Church to illuminate the front parking lot. It is our intention to illuminate the rear parking lot as well. One of the things we wish all of our organizations and members to keep in mind is that our utility costs are skyrocketing and we ask that whenever the Church Hall or library areas are used, that all lights and thermostats are turned off when leaving.

I would like to add a personal note of thanks to the Parish for permitting me to serve on the Parish Council for six years. Thank you also to those members of the Parish Council who have served with me, a thanks to Der Arten and Der Paree and also to our delegates.

ST. LEON'S DELEGATES' REPORT

1976

The 74th Annual Diocesan Assembly was held in Philadelphia from April 30th - May 2nd, 1976. Your delegates, Der Hayr, and Parish Council Chairman attended the Assembly. A new procedure was used to deliberate on matters before the Assembly. The delegates were separated into six groups. Each group was assigned a topic to discuss in depth with the objective of bringing recommendations to the Diocesan Assembly for votes on the various issues before the whole Assembly. The panel assignments generally coincided with the expressed areas of interest on the part of the delegates. On the whole it worked well and permitted more in depth discussion and deliberation on the issues than would be possible for the whole Assembly to give to each issue.

Below is a summary of the major issues discussed by the panels and voted upon by the Assembly:

Finance - The 1976 Budget for the Diocese as presented was \$526,000, approximately \$100,000 more than in 1975. This budget was discussed in detail and the necessity for the budget increase considered. It was noted that \$40,000 of the increase was for the Council of Religious Education and the Council for Armenian schools. Benefactors were contributing the total cost for these activities. The remaining \$60,000 increase was judged to be strictly inflationary cost increase for operations on the scale of the previous year, particularly fuel and utilities cost increases for the Cathedral complex.

The question of the procedures for determining Parish assessments was discussed. The Diocesan Council is required to present a detailed explanation of the assessment method for each parish.

<u>Proposals</u> - Each year a number of changes to the Diocesan by-laws are proposed. Below are some of the more significant amendments to the by-laws voted by the Assembly. The amendments are paraphrased in the interest of simplicity and brevity:

- 1. The Nominating Committee together with the Auditing Committee, shall govern all parish elections. (This proposal was approved the first time. It takes approval for two years before the amendment is adopted.)
- 2. The by-laws provide for a maximum of seven delegates from each parish. The proposal to remove this restriction was adopted. This was the first passage for this amendment.
- 3. The proposal requiring the Diocesan Council to provide clear guidelines on calculating the number of members in a parish was adopted.
- 4. The proposal requiring the Diocesan Council to submit a report to all parishes showing income and disbursements, membership figures and assessments for each parish was adopted.
- 5. A resolution was adopted requesting the Primate to appeal to all Armenians not to schedule social functions on the eve of Armenian holidays.

<u>Church Unity</u> - A great deal of discussion took place on the matter of Church Unity. Two recommendations were placed before the Assembly on which to vote. The first was a recommendation that the Assembly approve a Memorandum of Agreement approved by our Diocese Unity Committee and the Unity Committee of the Prelacy. The second was a recommendation by the Diocesan Council that the Assembly approve the same Memorandum of Agreement with what were considered minor changes in two areas. These changes were in the area of church cooperation before actual unity and methods of financial support to the Holy See of Cilicia.

Both sides presented their arguments. The Unity Committee's position was recommended on the basis that even the minor changes proposed by the Diocesan Council would undo all the negotiative effort expanded so far and require a new round of negotiations. They stressed that the major concessions have already been made by the Prelacy Committee and further concessions would be difficult to negotiate. The Diocesan Council maintained that its recommended changes were minor, reasonable and in any event were based on matters of principle.

The Diocesan Assembly approved the Diocesan Council recommendation of adopting the Unity Committee Memorandum of Agreement only with its recommended changes. Subsequently, the Prelacy Assembly adopted the Memorandum of Agreement with no changes. These events formed the basis for the opinion in some quarters that our Diocese is lacking sufficient enthusiasm for unity while the Prelacy is sincere in their efforts for unity. Your delegates do not ascribe to this point of view but acknowledge that further efforts must be made to dispel misunderstandings regarding the Diocesan position on unity.

Clergy, Youth and Education and Cultural Programs. Various proposals were adopted as represented by the following:

- 1. Increasing the number of priest candidates through an active recruiting program.
 - 2. Establish Bible School programs in the parishes.
- 3. Institute a special 2-year program for the preparation of priests for laymen who have already a good religious background and feel a calling to the priesthood.
- 4. Set up a committee to study possible reforms of the Liturgy, celebrate priesthood and participation of women in the Liturgy.

HISTORIAN COMMITTEE REPORT 1976

1976 was a big year for St. Leon Armenian Church and a year with many "firsts".

In February, for the first time the Nursery School came to church as a body and included the babies who had been baptized by Der Paree the previous year.

Also in February, one Sunday was devoted to an instructed Badarak during which Louise Kalemkerian and Seminarian Michael Chevian explained the entire service to the Sunday School children and parishioners present.

A five-session College Preparatory Seminar was held in March for high school seniors which included a panel discussion of the young group with about 20 parents in attendance. Dawn Hourdajian was the Guidance Counselor for this College Leader-ship Lab.

On April 25th, the traditional Madagh was observed in memory of the 1915 Martyrs instead of our usual observance at the Summer Picnic.

The new members of the Parish were welcomed by our Pastor,

Der Paree on May 16th at which time Der Hayre presented them

with a Certificate of Membership. Following church services,

the new members were honored at a Fellowship Coffee Hour.

St. Leon's 35th Anniversary was observed on May 23rd with The Gomidas Choir singing at the Badarak that morning. A dinner and hantess given by the Armenian School followed in the church hall.

Our first Vacation Bible School was held from June 28th - July 2nd. Zabelle Nalbantian, Margaret Haratounian and Zabelle Holopikian organized and directed the classes. Approximately 50 children attended this highly successful "first".

A special Parish Assembly was called on October 3rd by the Parish Council at which time the parishioners authorized the Parish Council to purchase a parcel of the Kirschener property adjacent to the church for \$40,000. On this date, the Assembly also gave approval for the formation of a Joint Committee with the A.G.B.U. for the purpose of discussing the possibility of a joint endeavor to build a Community Hall.

The month of November was set aside for the Reach Out Project. Rex Kachigian and Charles Pinajian were co-chairmen and 10 teams visited various families as potential members of our job. This project was most successful and resulted in 10 new families joining St. Leon.

On December 5th, Der Paree and Yerotzgin Angel hosted a dinner party at The Bon Fire Restaurant for the young couples who had been married in St. Leon's Church within the past five years. The intent was to establish a closer relationship between these couples and their church.

St. Leon's has started a tradition of sending a wedding anniversary card inviting the couples to celebrate their anniversary by attending church services on the Sunday closest to their wedding date and taking communion together.

The Historian Committee recommends that our church set aside the first Sunday of December each year to honor deceased benefactors by having a Requiem Badarak in their memory and inviting their families to attend church on that Sunday.

The Committee held five meetings during 1976, at which time they worked on the photograph book and the History of Our Church.






HOW THEY WERE SPENT

ST. LEON ARMENIAN CHURCH Proposal from Historian Committee

ST. LEON ARMENIAN CHURCH Proposal Submitted by Parish Council

Whereas, St. Leon Senior Center members wish to attend social gatherings and church services and they are unable to do so for lack of transportation.

Whereas, the youth of the parish are deprived from retreat experience, day excursions and group outings.

Whereas, Armenian and Sunday School classes could organize field trips during the week.

In short, a sport van or twelve passenger vehicle can help the church expand its role in the community, and it is important that St. Leon Parish provide that service.

Therefore, St. Leon Parish Council be authorized by the Parish Assembly to raise necessary funds from the parish for the purchase of said van.

Furthermore, it be authorized to insure and maintain said vehicle adequately and proceed with other related matters.

In the event, necessary funds are not raised from the parish, Parish Council be authorized to use reserve financial resources for the parish.

ST. LEON ARMENIAN CHURCH Proposal from Parish Council

The Parish Council recommends to the Parish Assembly that the Annual Membership Dues be increased from \$25.00 a year to \$50.00 a year retroactive to January, 1977, excluding Senior Citizens of 62 years of age and over whose dues shall remain at \$25.00 a year.
