December 31, 1983 Dear Parishioners:

It is my distinct pleasure to report to you once again on the progress of our parish for the year 1983. I am happy to report that our parish continues to show vitality and enthusiasm in meeting our challenges and responsibilities to our parishioners and community at large. As always we have tried to maintain a balanced perspective between our spiritual, social and cultural

Church services have been held regularly and Der Paree delivered sermons in English as well as Armenian. Our choir faithfully participated in all regular and special services with George Paroonagian as Director and Sirvart Galstian as our organist. This year we have been especially blessed with enhancement to our church services. Through the generous memorial donation of Vincent and Charlotte Abajian our church has a magnificent new organ.

The Parish Council continues to meet twice a month and I want to thank the members for their diligent effort to attend meetings, to discharge its duties and oversee various church activities. All members willingly assumed other duties in parish activities. One member, Alfred Ferraro regrettably resigned as a result of family relocation to Florida and his alternate, Rolan Hepsen is completing Al Ferraro's unfinished term of office.

The Special Committee, chaired by Sarkis Bedevian has made excellent progress. As you can see from the financial statements we have made substantial payments toward the reduction of our mortgage. This was made possible through the hard work of our committee members and your enthusiastic contributions in fulfilling your pledges and memorial donations. A similar effort in 1984 will attain our objective to repay the remaining balance of the mortgage.

In last year's report I had expressed the hope that the Community Center be self supporting withing a year or two. I am happy to say our expectations have been realized. This year the use fees exceeded our operating expenses for the center. Rex Kachigian, Vice Chairman of Parish Council and his able committee have done an admirable job. With the improvements to the center facilities, we have every confidence that the community center and the education facilities will be put to effective use beyond the needs of our parish activities and contribute to our annual budget.

Once again our parish this year was able to make its facilities available for a project on a regional basis. The Spiritual Life Conference held on March 19, was a big success.

We are indeed happy to once again have Berjouhi Feredjian as our Sunday School Superintendent with Susan Dadekian as Assistant Superintendent. Together, as a team, Berjouhi and Susan are doing a splendid job in educating our Sunday School Children. Our sincere appreciation to Barbara Hovsepian for her stewardship. Barbara now is spearheading our Bookstore. No doubt she will bring her usual dedication and enthusiasm to make the bookstore a regular stop for our parishioners on Sunday, after church service.

Our three sport teams made playoffs. Our girls once again brought the championship trophy to St. Leon and we celebrated everyone's success with our Annual Sports Dinner Program. Our thanks to the retiring coaches: Richard Tomasian, for Senior boys; Wayne Rallo, Junior boys; and Robert Ohnikian, for the girls. Robert has now taken over coaching our Senior boys teams and George Kachajian our girls teams. Our boys Junior team was late in organizing hence will not play the 1984 season.

Our Annual Bazaar was once again a financial, as well as social success, thanks to the untiring efforts of our Co-Chairmen, Harry Zoraian and Edward Torossian-with major efforts from our Women's Guild. Year after year the Women's Guild continues to be a bedrock for our many activities. This year's chairman was Florence—our thanks to her and her executive committee.

All of our other traditional events were held as usual. St. Leon's Name Day, Grape Blessing, Annual Car Raffle and Picnic. This year the date of the picnic was changed to July 4 and it was a major success under the chairmanship of Martin Kapoian and Jacques Tossounian.

Care and Share, Armenian School, Bible Study Group, continue as vital and growing activities of the parish. The Parish Council recognizing the need for our young couples to know one another and develop a relationship organized a get together on December 9. The idea has received support from our young couples. We hope they will develop into an ongoing organization and build on their common cultural heritage and mutual interests.

St. Nersess Seminary and its necessity is recognized by all of us. This year's New Year's Eve Celebration proceeds were donated to St. Nersess by mutual agreement of all sister parishes who jointly made the New Year's Eve a huge success. Mr. Sarkis Gabrellian deserves special recognition not only here but for wholehearted involvement in our major projects.

Our Church Secretary Alice Yazmajian has done a commendable job of maintaining church records and keeping things going. My report would be incomplete without recognizing the untiring and dedicated efforts of our Pastor, Fr. Paree and Yeretzgin Angel. Yeretzgin Angel, in her unassuming ways brings her contribution to the Choir, Sunday School, Armenian School and whenever called upon. The spiritual wellbeing of the parish and its youth continue to be Fr. Paree's primary concern and he is not reluctant to give his encouragement and support to all parish activities.

Two major events will take place in 1984. St. Leon will be the host parish for the Diocesan Assembly in May and we expect to celebrate our 50th Anniversary along with Mortgage Burning at a banquet in November. Both of these events can succeed only through the diligent efforts of every member of our parish. The magnitude of the projects requires committment on the part of each and everyone of us and I am sure together we will succeed.

The biggest asset of this parish is not its community center or its church property. Those things are material and can always be replaced. Our biggest is our spirit of togetherness and ability to pull together to achieve the impossible. There are times when these attributes are put to the test in front of difficulties. I have every confidence, in 1984 and beyond, we will overcome any such obstacles to continue to attain our goals.


