## MINUTES OF THE 1987 PARISH ASSEMBLY

## ST. LEON ARMENIAN CHURCH FAIR LAWN, N.J.

The Parish Assembly of St. Leon Armenian Church, 12-61 Saddle River Road, Fair Lawn, N.J., was called to order at 12:45 PM on Sunday, February 1, 1987, by Parish Council Chairman, Mirjan Kirian, who welcomed the members. There were 105 eligible voters present. Der Arshen opened the meeting with a prayer.

Elected from the floor were the following officers of the day:

ChairmanSarkis BedevianSecretaryMargaret TfankParlimentarianSarkis Soultanian

The Chairman changed the agenda, having elections held first to allow proper time for the counting of the ballots. Nominated from the floor for Nominating Committee slate was Berdj Feredjian. There being no further nominations, the slate was accepted as presented. The ballots were distributed and elections took place.

The 1986 minutes were accepted after the correction of a misprint.

The Pastor's report was read by Der Arshen Aivazian. He added that he had finished the required courses for his Doctorate degree and that only the testing and dissertation remain.

The Parish Council report was accepted as printed. Mirjan Kirian also stated that Varham Varjabedian has assumed Chairmanship of the Management Committee. Rex Kachigian thanked the following who served so well on this committee: Barbara Boghosian, Ann Kachigian, Rose Kirian, Grace Pinajian, Berjouhi Varjabedian, John Voskian and Violet Voskian. Also, Mr. Kirian thanked outgoing Parish Council members John Chagachbanian and John Nakashian.

#### **REPORTS OF ORGANIZATIONS:**

ACYOA

Leslie Boghosian apologized that the report was incomplete due to the fact that the ACYOA was not properly notified of this need. She requested that the ACYOA receive written notice of what was required. Since Gail Voskian no longer could be Advisor, Barbara Boghosian and Rose Najarian volunteered to be the new ones. Leslie reported that there were 27 paid members and the officers were:

#### DIOCESAN DELEGATES

1. Rex Kachigian asked where the money came from for the \$250,000 deficit. The new council will be asked about this in September. However, many books and publications for the Sunday School were donated.

2. Rose Najarian asked that the delegates' report be published in advance for the church members. Der Hayr stated next year's would be printed in the Lradoo immediately after the convention.

3. High-Rise Project - Sarkis Bedevian said that the Diocesan Council has approved the concept but that it now needs to give it more study.

4. The Diocesan Assembly responded to the matter of ordination of women with mixed feelings.

5. Endowment Fund - Two million dollars was raised this year from three wills alone. The Fund had five and a half million as of December 1986, the individual churches adding their funds to the Diocesan Fund for the purpose of greater interest yeild.

6. Church Unity - Rose Najarian felt that members should be told of progress in this direction. Der Hayr said that Zaven Dadekian is heading this independent committee in our church and it will meet in April.

#### SUNDAY SCHOOL

Regina Ohanian said that the loss shown in the report is really due to the purchase of new equipment for \$1,000 and 1,000 was given to the Diocese for new book printing.

#### SENIOR CENTER

Manoog Capan read a report in Armenian, stressed that the group is self-supporting, and gave a check for \$600 to the Parish Council. Alfred Voskian moved the report be included in the minutes. Carried.

#### BUILDING COMMITTEE

Vahram Varjabedian reported that the church has no loans or mortgages. The balance of \$16,000 on the pledges will be put aside for building repairs.

Jacques Tossounian, Chairman of the Auditing Committee, reported that the Treasurer's books for 1986 were examined and found to be in proper order. He suggested that all finances should be computerized.

Treasurer, Ara Hourdajian, presented the Proposed 1987 Budget which was passed unanimously. Discussed were:

- 1. Membership is dropping and pledge money is not increasing.
- 2. The 40% of the income is from the Community Center and that money should actually be used for improvements, repairs, etc.
- 3. Barbara Hovsepian, in showing need for money for the Sunday School new curriculum, was told that the Parish Council will give it from the general fund.
- 4. Secretarial expenses have increased due to more working hours on her part.
- 5. Steven Kachigian asked why Handicapped Ramps were not built since a vote to do so was passed last year. Mirjan Kirian said the plans had been unsatisfactory and new ones were a priority for the Parish Council.

#### NEW BUSINESS

Arthur Ohnikian stated that Handicapped Parking areas should be properly enforced by the Parish Council. Der Hayr and Parish Council members were given a vote of confidence to call police when necessary

Alfred Voskian asked why the Annual Report was not mailed two weeks in advance of the Annual Assembly as was voted on several years ago. Der Hayr said that delay in the financial statements held up the report.

Rex Kachigian moved that the Parish COuncil institute a Membership Drive in 1987. The motion was carried unanimously. NEW BUSINESS (cont.)

Rose Najarian, regarding the Church Unity subject, made the following resolution:

St. Leon's Parish, meeting at its Annual Assembly on February 1, 1987, expresses its feeling that the Parish, through its delegates, Parish Council, and other Church bodies, support all efforts within the Diocesan structure to accomplish Church Unity with the Prelacy.

Following the benediction by Der Arshen, the meeting was adjourned at 3:10 PM.

### PASTOR'S REPORT - 1987

Greetings to all of you in the name of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

It is with great satisfaction and contentment that I present this report of my activities for 1987. The progress made and the goals accomplished through the various activities and programs presented in this report reflect the dedication, the zeal and the cooperation of our parish members. Our parish life is rich and our activities are diverse. Accordingly, I would like to present them under four major categories as follows: (a) Educational projects; (b) Liturgical and Sacramental Life; (c) Pastoral ministries; and (d) Administration.

#### EDUCATIONAL PROJECTS

Education nurtures growth and maturity in all phases of our lives, including the spiritual. Consequently, I have tried to impliment as many educational programs as feasable to facilitate and to respond to the needs of our parishioners. Our two major programs for the education of our children, namely the Armenian Language School and the Sunday Church School, are functioning very well under the able leadership of their respective staffs and faculties). Our Church School is currently implimenting the new curriculum published by the Diocesan Department of Religious Education and so far the response is generally very favorable. I personally continue to teach the students of the high school grades (10th,11th and 12th), with a specially designed course. This special curriculum includes basic courses on Holy Scripture, Armenian Church Doctrine, Liturgy, Sacraments, contemporary moral issues and Church history. The Adult Education Programs continued to be offered for those who wish to learn more about the teachings and practices of the Armenian Church. In the Fall a five-week course was offered on the Divine Liturgy with eight parishioners regularly attending. It is my hope that more people will take advantage of these course offerings. The Pre-Cana Sessions instituted in 1986 was offered again last year in an improved format. They have helped our young people to better understand the christian dimension of the Sacrament of Marriage and thus build stronger foundations for their married lives. It is my intention to continue these programs and improve and expand them where necessary. I also intend to continue the publication of the weekly Sunday Bulletin and the parish newsletter "Lradoo", using them as effective tools to provide consice information on our Armenian-Christian faith and heritage.

On a more personal note, as you all know, I am enrolled in the PH.D. program in Theology at Fordham University, NYC. Currently, I have completed the required courses and I am preparing for my comprehensive examinations which I plan to take, God willing, in the fall of this year.

# LITURGICAL AND SACRAMENTAL LIFE

The Liturgy of our Church is the center of our spiritual life. It is with great satisfaction that I note the active participation of our parishioners in the liturgical and Sacramental life of our Church.

During the course of 1987 the following sacraments and sacramentals were administered. 10 baptisms, 2 adult chrismations, 13 weddings and 18 funerals. In addition, in my capacity as the Pastor of St. Leon's, I have participated in 6 weddings and 5 funerals held in other area Churches. Moreover, sacramental liturgies were administered on 32 separate occasions. It is very gratifying for me as a priest to witness the increasing number of people who seek the sacraments of the Church in the various stations of their lives. The regular partaking by many of the faithful in the Eucharistic Liturgy is a clear indication that the church is playing a central role in our lives. With a view to further encourage this development, I have tried to pay as much care and attention as possible to the Sunday homilies. My effort is always to draw from the Scripture a lesson that applies the teachings of the Church to our contemporary lives. Ultimately, our lives must reflect the earthly life of our Lord Jesus Christ and accordingly, special attention was paid to the liturgies of special feasts and seasons. In their commemoration and celebration of our Lord's life the special liturgies of Christmas, Lent, Holy Week and the major feasts of the liturgical year helps us to further focus our attention on our own lives as Christians. Our liturgies not only reflect our Christian values, but also they embody many of the traditions that express our faith and the faith of our forebears.

At this time, allow me to offer my thanks and appreciation to our Choir Director George Paroonagian, Organist Sirvart Galstian, Chairman Dr. Berdj Feredjian and all our deacons, subdeacons, acolytes, and our choir members for their dedicated participation in our liturgies throughout the year. Thanks also are due to Mrs. Grace Pinajian and Mrs. Nevart Siranoush Boyajian and the group of volunteers who help them, for their time in the preparation of "Mahs".

#### PASTORAL MINISTRIES

One of the most important facets of Church life is pastoral ministries. According to the teachings of our Church, our chief pastor is Our Lord Jesus Christ, who is represented to us in the person of our Diocesan Bishop, and the priests who are assigned by him as pastors of local parishes. Thus, in my capacity as pastor I tried to reach out and be present whenever the need arose. In this respect, I continued family visitations on a regular basis, as well as visitations to the sick and the grieved whether at home or in the hospital. I have made myself available to all those who have sought my pastorial support and counseling for various situations in their personal lives, on 92 separate occasions. In addition, I continue to provide baptismal, wedding, marital, family and individual counseling to members of our parish on 58 occasions.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE

As Parish Priest, my responsibilities include the day to day administration of our parish. In this capacity I supervised the work of the church office and the physical maintanance of our parish facilities. As ex-officio president of the various church organizations and as a representative of St. Leon's parish I attended various Diocesan, parish and community events on 97 separate occasions.

Before closing this report, I would like to offer my thanks to the Chairman of the Parish Council Arthur Ohnikian for his able leadership and to all the members of the Parish Council for their dedicated work. Thanks also to our Diocesan delegates, the chairpersons and executive committee members of all our parish organizations and committees. Special thanks to our secretary Mrs. Natalie Merten who has been of great assistance to me in my adminstrative work.

Lastly, my heartfelt thanks to all our parishioners for their dedication and committment. Without your support and cooperation the above mentioned activities and accomplishments could not have been realized.

I look forward to the coming year, to grow together with God's blessings.

#### PARISH COUNCIL REPORT - 1987

#### Dear Fellow Parishioners:

It is with less than complete satisfaction that I report to you of our accomplishments during this past year. We have made satisfactory progress in some areas, but have not been able to achieve all our goals.

St. Leon was fortunate this year to discover we had an untapped source of new leadership. Three members became firsttime chairmen: Antoine Moomdjian for our Annual Picnic; Leon Hovsepian for the Food/Festival Bazaar; and David Soultanian for our New Year's Eve Dance. As usually occurs, new people provide new direction and their novel concepts were much in evidence and greatly appreciated.

Approval was given at our last Parish Assembly for the establishing of a Membership Committee. Unfortunately, due to overwork of its members this very important project did not reach fruition. I am hopeful that we will have actual progress this spring. If there was more active participation by our parishioners, St. Leon would already be benefitting from increased membership instead of anticipating progress.

During 1987, we formed a committee to determine the feasibility of expanding and improving our physical facilities a new church entry with handicap facilities and an enlarged narthex and Parish Council office; enlarging the Church proper and providing additional office space and conference room. The members of this committee were also those who fostered our Community Center which now provides about one-third of our annual budget. As one who was not completely in favor of that project at the time, I now wonder how we would be operating if our membership did not have the foresight to approve the plans of these same members.

We expanded participation as ushers for Church Service by seeking out ACYOA, Jrs. and the Senior Citizens who both accepted our proposal. This is open to others willing to participate.

There were three noteworthy community-wide events that warrant citing. In what became one of the most widely attended events in our history, we sponsored a slide presentation by Gregory Parseghian of his climb of Mt. Ararat. In addition, there were two unity-oriented events. The first was a panel discussion on Church Unity, the second was a Unity Prayer Breakfast sponsored by ACYOA, Jrs. Both were well attended.

I would like to thank Der Hayr for his availability, dedication and guidance in enabling me to serve in this capacity, and for all of you who answered our call for assistance. Particular thanks to the Women's Guild who always labors so hard for the good of St. Leon, and extremely vital to all, the Manggament Committee which supervises the use of the Community Center and does such an effective job in providing us with a very substantial amount of needed revenue.

The Spirit of St. Leon, as in other churches, is still in its parishioners. We are indeed fortunate to have so many diligent members who give of themselves to work for the Church. Some overextend themselves. Others limit themselves to a favorite organization. There is, however, a need to work for the entire church through more than just one of its auxilaries. I urge you to become more involved...St. Leon needs your help!
