In pursuance of the precedents and experiences established in its 1974 session, the Armenian School conducted a 7-week program of accelerated learning based on the integration of Armenian language, history, dance and music. A total of 2A regular students attended 2 hr classes from 11:00 to 1:00 on Saturdays in the Church Hall. A number of new instructional aids were introduced including new books and films brought from the Diocesean Office. The instructional staff consisted of Fr. Kevork, Dr. Vazken Alexanian, Gus Kerjilian, Rose Keyian, Armen Boyajian, Paul Ketchoyan and Dr. Hrair Dekmejian.

In view of its great success, it was decided to institute a new Spring session beginning on January 17 and ending on February 28 with an official Hantes on Sunday Febr. 29 commemorating the martyrdom and victory of St. Vartan.

To be effective, the Armenian School needs one additional classroom and the wholehearted support of every Armenian in the Triple Cities on Febr. 29th
