It was a very successful year for the Saturday morning Armenian school. Five students were enrolled this year. For the first four weeks, the curriculum was based on short dialogues which the students learned and said together during class, plus a fifteen minute Armenian sing-time. Then, kiss Sylva DerStepanian, from the Language Lab of the Diocese, gave a two hour presentation, showing all the materials available from the lab. As a result, books were ordered, and worksheets, which the church already had were used. Now, reading, writing, and grammar are being extensively covered by the book and the worksheets. In the coming weeks, students will be learning the Armenian names for the geometric shapes, how to tell the time in Armenian, more vocabulary, plus an occasional game of Armenian Password or Dominoes.
