1) 4th quarter 1997 performance, comparing with the same quarter of the previous year.
 To begin with, the total revenue for the 4th quarter of 1997 was 104,000 compared to 100,000 in the 4th quarter of 1996.
 This represents a 4% increase in revenue.
 The gross margin for the 4th quarter of 1997 was 55% compared to 52% in the 4th quarter of 1996.
