## THE ARMENIAN CHURCH OF THE HOLY RESURRECTION 11 ERWIN PLACE NEW BRITAIN. CONNECTICUT

Annual Parish Assembly-Jan. 27, 1974

The annual parish assembly of the Armenian Church of the Holy Resurrection was held on January 27, 1974. The meeting was called to order at 2:10 p.m. Father Vartan DerAssadourian opened the meeting with a prayer.

Stephen DerMargosian served as chairman for the day. Mrs. Queenie Hovhanessian served as secretary.

Charles Hovsepian, Jr. read the parish assembly minutes of 1973. A motion was made by Mrs. Margaret Bagdigian to accept the minutes as read. Miss Sarah Yagoobian seconded the motion. Minutes were accepted.

Father Vartan read the pastor's report. The parish council report was read by Charles Hovsepian, Jr. The auditor's report was read by Hurach Azarigian. Mrs. Henrietta Kallajian made a motion to accept all three reports; seconded by Mrs. Lillian Azarigian. All three reports were accepted as read.

Most of the reports were very enlightening and showed that our parish had made some progress in 1973.

Under new business Mrs. Arshal Hoosigian made a motion to confirm the parish prest for the next 5 years; seconded by Charles Hovsepian, Jr. The assembly gave a unanimous vote of approval to have Father Vartan as their pastor for the next 5 years.

Arthur Simonian gave a brief resume on joint ventures given during 1975 with the Hartford parish. The church picnic; Women's Guild dinner-dance; A.C.Y.O.A. socials.

The 1974 Budget was presented by Arthur Simonian. Berj Kallajian made a motion to accept the 1974 budget at \$14,900.00. Monoog Bagdigian seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Mrs. Rose Yessian proposed that some sort of saish-kebob dinner be given on our **St**anley Street property in 1974 to give us additional income and to introduce "something different".

John Maljanian made a motion: that the treasurer of the trustees conduct the audit of books of church organizations--A.C.Y.O.A., Women's Guild, Choir, etc. in accordance with the Diocesan by-laws and ascertain as a minimum the calendar year income, expense and year-end balance for each organization. This data is then to be turned over to the auditing committee who will consolidate the annual financial report to include the records of the Church as well as the organizations and show line item breakdown of income, expense and year-end balance in a final financial summary. This summary would then be presented,

in addition to other records, at the annual Parish Assembly. The motion was seconded by John Hovhanessian. Motion was carried.

Miss Saran Yagoobian made a motion that the parish council take the necessary steps to paint with yellow paint the necessary markings in front of the gates of the parking lot to prevent cars parking and then having to be towed away. Mrs. Lillian Azarigian seconded the motion. It was passed.

Results of the voting were presented at this time. (Attachea)

Mrs. Edward Simonian made a motion that provision be made in our by-laws for absentee balloting; the Parish Council to formulate the resolution to be submitted to the Diocesan Assembly in 1974. Mrs. Susan DerMargosian seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

John Hovhanessian made a recommendation that the date of termination be carefully srutinized on the two-year certificate we hold at the bank and proper action be taken in the proper time period (presently 10 days) to change over to a four-year certificate if so chosen.

Motion was made and seconded to close the meeting at about 4:05 p.m. Father Vartan closed the meeting with a few words to the assembly of "thanks" for the orderly fashion in which the meeting was conducted and also for unanimous approval of his pastorate; He is happy to serve the New Britain community and have them for a family!! Father Vartan said a prayer and the meeting adjourned.
