CEMETARY REPORT  
1996

For the benefit of our newer members, our church owns the burial rights for approximately 75-80 percent of Section 23 in the City Owned Fairview Cemetary in New Britain, Ct.

We emphasize Burial Rights because we do not own the Land. We set prices for the grave sites based on Church Membership as opposed to non-members.

We have a complete map of our portion of Section 23 as well as the burial records for all persons buried in our section. It should be noted here that Fairview Cemetary also has all records for Section 23 and we check periodically to be sure that our records agree.

At the present time there are 108 available plots. We are in the process of buying back 3 plots that the original purchaser will not use. We are also hopeful that there will be 2 other plots that will be donated to the church.

In the near future we hope to have new maps made as well as modernizing our records.


The City's Fairview Cemetary operation seems to be running smoothly with no problems at the present time. The cemetary is now under the control of the Parks & Recreation Department. The two employees that we work with are:

As of this report, the fence at the furthest corner of Fairview Cemetary, near our Section 23, has been repaired. Hopefully it will stay repaired.

For those who have purchased burial plots & wish to set Monuments in place in advance, please work with Fairview Personnel and the monument installer to be certain the stone goes over the proper grave(s). And, if you are going to have the names inscribed on the stone, please refer to your cemetary receipt so the names will be inscribed in the proper order. (If there will be more than one name on the stone).

We had one problem with this that has been corrected & hopefully it will not happen again.
