Item 8 on the agenda, the elections will be held on Sunday, January 25, 1970, at 10:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. as a continuation of the Annual Parish Assembly of January 22, 1970.

The Nominating Committee with the Very Reverend Muron Gurjikian, President; Charles H. Garabedian, Chairman; Manesse Jardarian, Secretary; Ara Eresian, Suney Kachadoorian, Jacob Hagopian established rules and conducted the voting.

The first item of business was to elect Bartev Bagdasarian, Chairman and George Krikorian, Secretary of the Assembly.

Our Pastor presented his 1969 Annual Report in Armenian as recorded on pages one, two, three of the 1969 Annual Report. His report was recorded also in English on pages four, five, and six of the report for those who didn't understand Armenian. Motion to acceptwas made, seconded, and approved by the Assembly. The Parish Council report as recorded on pages seven, eight, nine, and ten was read by Van Aroian, Secretary. The following ommission was noted and the following members have been added to the Centennial Committee and are to be included on page nine: Harold Gregory, Mrs. Manasse Jardarian, Mrs. Sharvaz Kazarian, the Very Reverend Muron Gurjickian and assisting the Committee: Mrs. Antraneg Yarumian, Mr. Ara Eresian, and Mrs. John Toromanian.

Mr. Edward Belzerian read the Auditing Committee Report as recorded on pages eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, and fifteen of the 1969 Annual Report and was approved by the assembly.

Bartev Bagdasarian answered all questions from the assembly pertaining to the Cultural Center Building Fund Financial Report as outlined on page eleven of the 1969 Annual Report after which said report was approved by the Parish Assembly.

Zarvin Kasparian, Chairman of the Parish Council presented a report on the financial condition of our parish and subsequently ably assisted by John Toromanian, Treasurer, answered those questions raised by the Assembly regarding income and disbursements.

Our Church Operation Budget for 1970 as recorded on page sixteen of the 1969 Annual Report in the amount of \$57,600.00 waspresented and unanimously accepted by the assembly members.

Miss Clara Takesian Answered questions concerning programs of the Sunday Church School, with a special emphasis on the great need of a Superintendent for the Sunday Church School. Particular needs to strengthen the Armenian School as well as the Sunday Church School were cited.

A motion was made and approved to arrange a special meeting to find means of strengthening both the Armenian Language School, the Sunday Church School and religious education. An additional strong pleaswas presented by Miss Clara Takesian to bring the younger people, ages eighteen through twenty-five, into the church community and get them involved.

A motion was made and approved to have the Council investigate the possibility of changing the date of the Annual Meeting.

The first session or portion of the 1970 Annual Parish Assembly ended at 10:45 P.M. with the second session or portion of the Annual Parish Assembly due to open Sunday, January 25, 1970, at 9:30 A.M. for the purpose to conducting elections for members to the Parish Council, Auditing Committee and Nominating Committee.

Mr. Ara Eresian, after the reading of the Church Choir Report, introduced the subject of the Church's need for an organ and the possibility of embarking on some program to acquire same.

The acceptance of the Men's Club Report was conditional upon deleting the line - Mr. No-Body - as Recording Secretary of the Men's Club. Motioned and carried.

The second session was opened as arranged at 9:30 A.M. Sunday, January 25, 1970, with the sealing of the Balk Box under the auspices of our Pastor, Reverend Muron Gurjikian. Two hundred and fourteen ballots were cast between 9:30 A.M. and closing at 1:00 P.M. after which the Nominating Committee counted and tallied the following results:
