Women's Guild The Armenian Church of Westchester

On March 26, 1975, under the spiritual leadership of Rev. Fr. Karekin Kasparian, an initial organizational meeting was held at the home of Mrs. Ruth Sanossian by fifteen concerned women for the major purpose of forming the Women's Guild of the Armenian Church of Westchester. Since it was the unanimous feeling of those present that every church needs a Women's Guild which actually becomes its very "backbone," Der Hayr emphasized the special need for meeting all our spiritual, moral, social, religious, educational, and cultural needs along with enjoying warm fellowship with each other. The ideas expressed were overwhelmingly received.

- 12. Were responsible for the sale of 95 <u>New Gourmet Cookbooks</u> put out by Young Women's Auxiliary of The Holy Trinity Armenian Apostolic Church of Greater Boston
- 13. Lecture on "A Profile of Armenian Cultural Heritage" by Rev. Fr. Kasparian, supplemented with colored slides
- 14. Lecture by Miss Valerie Goekjian on the Virgin Mother and the Armenian women saints
- 15. Contributed individually to the St. Andrew's Barn Sale
- 16. Held a Christmas Party in December with an exchange of gifts
- 17. Planned future programs for 1976 beginning with demonstrated talks on the art-of-belly dancing, macrame, Yoga, Ikebana (art of Jápanese flower arranging) and other similar crafts
