The year 1977 began with a successful banquet climaxing the 1976 Bi-Centennial Thanksgiving Drive. The enthusiasm and positive mood generated that day was reassurance that a large number of the community are supportive of the efforts of the Committee and the goal of the Church to purchase suitable property.
