3. Hosted a Lenten Dinner during the period of Lent.

4. Held a Special Dinner meeting and Social consisting of a complimentary cookout barbeque dinner.

5. Game and Card Parties.

The Men's Club also actively participated in the Annual Consecration Dinner, Bazaars, Kef Nite, and other dinners and events held by our various Church Auxiliaries.

Our members played prominent roles in serving on the Management Committee and offered many personal contributions of time, material, and labor to meet the needs of the Church.

The Men's Club plans in 1983 to continue to chair the Annual Picnic, which will be on a grander scale, and the New Year's Eve Party. A fishing trip is planned for the Spring. Other special events will be discussed and planned by the Men's Club during the course of the new year which will be of interest to our Church and Community.
