1. Installation of new translucent windows for the Sanctuary. The advice and assistance of the Memorials Committee were received with appreciation.
2. Renovation of the Kitchen in the Parish House, which included the installation of new kitchen equipment. Thanks are due particularly for the efforts of George Davidian, Michael Pisani, Jerry Ksayian, and Gino Urbinelli.
3. Installation of the Cross and Church Name on the exterior Church edifice. George Davidian expedited the acquisition and the mounting of the Cross and Church Name in time for Christmas Services, with the help of Jerry Ksayian, Berge Derdiarian, James Cassidy, Michael Pisani, Edward Essayian, and Ara Shimshidian.

Planning Committee - Chairman Jack Hachigian has met with the architect, Mr. Matthew Warshauer of Elmsford, and that two, perhaps three options of the Site Plan will be prepared for a fee of \$2500.

Fifty Club - In lieu of holding a raffle, the 50 Club was formed to generate income for the Church, with the goal of selling 200 tickets at \$50 per ticket. Forty percent of the total amount collected would then be distributed as cash prizes. Drawings for four prizes were held each month for a period of four months. Although we did not meet the goal of 200 tickets, we were able to realize a profit in excess of \$4000 through the faithful efforts of the Chairperson Martha Gurahian and with the participation of all those who contributed to make this a success.

Telephone Directory - A Telephone Directory of all Armenians residing in Westchester and Southern Connecticut was prepared under the direction of the Pastor, and distributed. Approximately 600 copies were mailed to Church members and non-members alike. Non-members were urged to become active in our Church affairs.
