

## MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY

of the

HOLY CROSS ARMENIAN CHURCH OF UNION CITY, N. J.

January 28, 1979

Following Church Services on January 28, 1979, Mr. Philip Arpiarian, Chairman of the Parish Council, called the meeting to order. Nubar Dorian and Arpena Sbarbaro were elected Chairman and Secretary of the Annual Meeting, respectively. The meeting was then recessed for lunch.

The meeting was reconvened at 1:05 PM by Chairman Nubar Dorian. There were 71 participating members present. Jack Takakjian made a motion that the balloting be closed at 2:00 PM. The motion was seconded and passed.

Philip Arpiarian requested that the annual reports of parish organizations be in the hands of Der Hayr no later than January 5 of each year so that they can be reproduced and mailed in advance of the meeting to the parishioners for their review.

It was decided to dispense with the reading of the organizational reports. However, the Chairman invited the Church auxiliaries to answer any questions pertinent to their reports.

Mr. Zaven Hovsepian moved that Der Hayr's report be accepted with thanks and appreciation for his work on the monthly VISION and Sunday Bulletins. Matilde Kalbian expressed thanks to Der Hayr and Harold Azmelian for making possible the parking facilities at the Yeshiva School. It was pointed out that the originator of this idea was Jack Sasoonian. Virginia Shenloogian commended Anne Hachadoorian and all those responsible for this year's beautiful Parish Christmas card. Paul Takakjian suggested that future reports be printed in English and Armenian.

Harold Azmelian moved that all reported be accepted as submitted. Motion was seconded and carried.

Richard Hachadoorian presented a report on behalf of the Auditing Committee. All books were audited and found to be in order.

The Parish Assembly then took up the following items which were presented at the request of the Parish Council.

1. Parking: Jack Takakjian reported that when parking in the Yeshiva School lot, all cars should be angled (toward New York Avenue), keeping close to the car next to you. There is more space behind the school; therefore, the alley must reamin unblocked and accessible at all times. No cars should be parked in the alley. Small cars can be parked toward the fence, also at an angle. In this way 30-40 cars can be accommodated. It was suggested that the Church attendance cards with the owner's name be placed in the windshield.

- 2. Endowment and Permanent Trust Fund: Ludwig Shahbazian presented his report. Some individuals have been contacted to participate in this Fund. Any amount is acceptable to start a fund and can be increased at any time. More contacts are planned. At this time, Jack and Trudy Takakjian donated \$100.00 to start a Trust Fund in their name.
- 3. Pledge System: Philip Arpiarian stated that the Pledge System had not been fully implemented during the past year, but that next year it will be carried out. A request was made that parishioners think in terms of increasing the amount of their pledges due to the ever-increasing expenses of the Church.
- 4. Bingo: Jack Takakjian reported that the target date for Bingo is September. Carol Moomjy-Grossi is chairing this committee, but manpower is desperately needed. All those interested in helping on this project are requested to contact Jack Takakjian.

At 2:10 PM - a motion was made by Virginia Shenloogian that balloting be closed. Motion was seconded and carried.

- 5. Building Committee: Deran Chopoorian reported that there are certain areas which need repair and/or improvement:
  - a) Church: Repair of water damaged walls, painting, carpeting, front sidewalk.
  - b) Annex: Complete renovation to include paneling, replacement of windows, new floor covering, kitchenette facilities.
  - c) Parish House: Aluminum siding on building, replacement of windows, repair of front entrance.
  - d) Church Center: Installation of hood over cooking area and realignment of electrical circuits.

Motion was made by Virginia Shenloogian that a vote of confidence be given to the Parish Council to proceed with the repairs. Second and carried.

The review of these items was temporarily interrupted to bring the results of the elections to the attention of the Assembly.

- 6. Increasing of monies which the Parish Council is allowed to spend (not part of the budget) from \$500 to \$1,000. Motion was made by Armen Kalbian to change the amount the Parish Council can spend should the need arise to \$1,000. Motion was seconded and carried.
- 7. By-Laws and duties of a Diocesan Delegate for our own Parish. Since there is no direction from the Diocese as to the duties of a Delegate a motion was made by Richard Hachadoorian that the Parish Council present to the next Parish Assembly by-laws and duties of a diocesan delegate.

Ludwig Shahbazian, who has served as a delegate for many years, was asked for his comments. He suggested that the following might be some ideas to include as duties of a diocesan delegate: a) that the diocesan delegate must attend Parish Council meetings; b) that the diocesan delegate run the elections of the Parish Assembly acting as the Nominating Committee.

Another suggestion made from the Assembly floor was that the Diocesan Delegates present a written report on the Diocesan Assembly to the Annual Parish Assembly.

8. Definition of Annual Dues: Der Hayr infored the parishioners that our dues is \$25 yearly. Monies given for Christmas, Easter, Prayers, etc. will not be credited for dues. Motion was made by Thomas Dabakian that membership dues be taken out of the pledge made by members, implemented through the envelope system or an outright check earmarked for that purpose. Christmas and Easter offerings, as well as other donations are not to be considered part of that membership dues. Motion was seconded and passed.

### Old Business:

Philip Arpiarian advised the Assembly that the first meeting of the Mr Mrs. & Ms. or Three M's Club was held on Saturday evening, January 27, 1979. A committee has been formed to look into establishing by-laws for that group.

#### New Business:

It was suggested to the Nominating Committee that it bring the names of the nominees to the attention of the parish prior to the election.

Nubar Dorian stated that for the amount of dues-paying members our parish has, the turn-out today attendance-wise was excellent. He gave special commendation to Der Hayr for his untiring work and wonderful leadership during the past year; to Philip Arpiarian as Chairman of the Parish Council; and to the Parish Council members.

Der Hayr then thanked the Parish Council for its work during the past year and especially to Philip Arpiarian for his patience and leadership. He commended Anne Hachadoorian for the varied duties she carries out. He congratulated all those elected today and gave special thanks to the outgoing Parish Council Members stressing that as a member of the Parish, whether we are Parish Council Members or not, we should all feel our obligation to work for the Church. He requested that we give special attention to the Permanent Trust Fund and to the Pledge System. Der Hayr was also happy to comment that the Women's Guild has been revitalized and that in the near future there will hopefully be a reorganization of a Senior ACYOA.

The meeting was closed at 3:30 PM with a prayer by Der Hayr and the singing of the Hayr Mer.

## PASTOR'S REPORT

The year 1979 was a good period of time for our Parish in many ways.

As we analyze the 1979 year income, we notice that there are improvements in some areas.

- 1. Pledges and Envelopes through the generosity and cooperation of our parishioners the Pledge Committee was able to raise over \$9.000. I have two recommendations to make:
  - a. To raise the ceiling of the pledge to \$15,000 and with the greater effort and participation of all parishioners we should be able to reach that goal.
  - b. To encourage everybody to use weekly envelopes for their yearly pledges. It will make it easier for both the Parish Council and participants to handle.
- 2. Renovations as you have noticed, general renovations have started with the church, which is almost completed. Still, there are many areas; namely, the Annex, Parish House and outside of the Church that need immediate alteration. For this work, we need over \$20,000. Therefore, it is important that we support the Renovation Fund by sending our donations and educating others to do the same.
- 3. Big Raffle during 1979 we had a car raffle which brought over \$7,000 net profit. I urge you not only to buy raffles, but also to help the committee to sell tickets so that we can continue this venture every year.

I would like to give you the highlights of my activities:

- 1. Worship Church Services were conducted regularly every Sunday as well as several other special holidays and occasions. We have a very devoted Choir. Our faithful deacons, Hagop Hovsepian and Thomas Dabakian; Choir leaders Ann Dadaian and Arpena Sbarbaro; organists, Lucy Soovajian, Dawn Foronjy and Linda Papazian, as well as all the members, deserve special thanks from all of us.
- 2. Rituals during the year 1979 the administration of the Sacraments and Rites have been in numbers:
  - 5 Baptisms

5 Weddings

18 Funerals

- 3. Organizations I am glad to see that our organizations are trying their utmost to be active and help the church in its progress.
- 4. Schools this year the Sunday School was able to establish a Nursery Department. I hope every year we will be able to improve the schools and increase their numbers so that we can serve our children in the best manner by raising them in the faith and culture of our forefathers.

- 5. Meetings during the past year, I presided over all the meetings of our organizations and of special committees, wherever possible.
- 6. Office Work the following office work was done during 1979:
  - a. Preparation of sermon for every Sunday in both languages.
  - b. Publication of monthly newsletter VISION and weekly Sunday Bulletin on time.
  - c. Preparation of numerous flyers, program booklets, correspondence and other printing were done and mailed throughout the year.

For all this office work, we should extend special thanks to Ann Dadaian for her great devotion and service to her church.

I would like at this time to thank all those people who did their best to help the church to progress. Also, I shall pray for the others so that they also will join our present active workers and together we can do greater things for our church.

Let us also pray to God to grant us good health in order to be able to continue serving our beloved Holy Cross of Union City and for the glory of God.

#### HOLY CROSS ARMENIAN CHURCH OF UNION CITY

#### RECOGNITION COMMITTEE

The RECOGNITION COMMITTEE shall have the responsibility for selecting those individuals, past and present, who have through their participation and/or sacrifice c-ntributed outstandingly towards the continuous existence of the Holy Cross Armenian Church of Union City, New Jersey, since its founding in 1906.

The RECOGNITION COMMITTEE shall be responsible for searching out candidates, reviewing the background of each candidate and making the final selection of those most worthy of this special RECOGNITION.

The RECOGNITION COMMITTEE shall be comprised of the Parish Priest, the Chairperson of the Parish Council and one member in good standing from each of the following church affiliated organizations:

WOMEN'S GUILD
LADIES EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY
CHOIR
THREE "M" CLUB
PARISH COUNCIL
DIOCESAN DELEGATE

The Parish Priest shall have the title of President and the Parish Council Chairperson shall be the Chairperson of the RECOGNITION COMMITTEE.

A Secretary shall be elected from the membership of the RECOGNITION COMMITTEE and shall maintain minutes of the meetings and all records regarding the candidates considered for RECOGNITION.

All funds required to support the RECOGNITION COMMITTEE and its activities shall be provided by the Holy Cross Armenian Church through a petty cash account in the name of the RECOGNITION COMMITTEE.

The RECOGNITION COMMITTEE shall meet a minimum of two times a month to conduct its business.

All requests for RECOGNITION must be accompanied with detailed information regarding the individual's participation and/or sacrifice so that the RECOGNITION COMMITTEE members may evaluate each candidate.

All balloting for selection of an individual for RECOGNITION will be conducted by secret ballot with all of the committee members present. To qualify for RECOGNITION a candidate must receive 75 per cent of the votes. Each member of the RECOGNITION COMMITTEE shall have one vote.

Each year a maximum of four persons may be singled out for RECOGNITION. At least one of those selected shall be currently active in the Church.

The individuals or the families of deceased persons selected for RECOGNITION shall be presented with a certificate proclaiming the honor and a pin symbolic of their achievements.

The names of all those individuals who have been RECOGNIZED shall be included on a special plaque to be displayed in the Church.

Periodically the RECOGNITION COMMITTEE shall organize a dinner to honor all of those individuals who have been RECOGNIZED.

The presentation of the RECOGNITION certificate and pin shall take place on a Sunday, at an appropriate time during the Badarak, during the period between Easter and the last Sunday in June.

#### · SURVEY COMMITTEE REPORT

1979

The Holy Cross Survey Committee organized itself during the early part of the year. The purpose of this survey was to update our mailing list and to organize programs and activities for the interest and enrichment of all church family members.

On March 1, the committee sent a letter and questionnaire, both in English and Armenian, to everyone on the church mailing list. A follow-up letter was mailed on August 20 as a reminder to return the completed questionnaire.

As a result, out of 403 questionnaires, 99 were returned. This survey is based on the total responses.

As a conclusion to our efforts, we shall coordinate the talents and interests put in the questionnaire so that accordingly the Parish Council can utilize the talents and organize acitivites.
