MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY

JANUARY 31, 1982

Following Church Services on January 31, 1982, Mr. Philip Arpiarian, Chairman of the Parish Council, called the meeting to order. Matilde Kalbian and Nubar Dorian were elected Secretary and Chairman of the Annual Meeting, respectively. Mr. Arpiarian then asked for more nominations from the Parishioners for Parich Council, Auditing and Nominatig Committees. Claire Hovsepian's name was submitted for Auditing Committee and nominations were closed with a suggestion for write-in names if necessary. The meeting was temporarily adjourned for lunch.

It reconvened at 1:15 PM with the Chairman welcoming the parishioners to the 76th Annual Meeting of the Holy Cross Armenian Church. Thomas Dabakian made a motion to close the ballot box at 1:30 PM. Motion was seconded and passed.

Mr. Dorian read the highlights of last year's minutes and since there were no additions or corrections, a motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes as presented. Motion was carried.

It was decided to dispense with the reading of the organization reports since the Annual Report booklet has been available to parishioners for reading one week previous to the Annual Meeting. Any questions or comments regarding these reports were brought up at this time.

The following points were made:

- 1. Der Hayr commented that only 36 people were present. Parishioners should be aware that their presence as well as their contributions are very necessary to run a healthy Church. Everyone should share in the work of running the Church not relying only on the Parish Council members.
- There should be a determined effort to get the younger generation to participate in the operation of the Church - become dues paying members.
- 3. The endowment fund has a good base and should be in everyone's agenda to participate.
- 4. Unfortunately, our ACYO has been very inactive this year. The only solution to a better ACYOA is <u>full</u> parent cooperation.
- 5. A question arose as to why the Bolsetzi families do not participate more in Church governing. Der Hayr commented that their backgrounds are very different, and it will take some time before they will want to participate. They are very generous and we do appreciate them whenever they come.

6. Philip Arpiarian reported on two of the projects the Parish Council had undertaken - the membership committee and recognition committee. They have been relatively inactive and hopefully they will do more in the cominb year.

Nubar Dorian asked for a count of the votes cast. It was 53.

Lud Shahbazian gave a report on the Endowment Fund. There is \$20,600 in cash and \$5,539 in stocks. The tultimate goal of the fund is to use the interest for conducting the business of the Church. The goal for 1982 is \$50,000. At this time, Mr. and Mrs. John Radoian donated \$500. Eventually there will also be a plaque listing the names of the donors.

Philip Arpiarian announced that the Women's Guild donated \$2,000 to the Church and Armen Kalbian announced that the Senior Citizens Club donated \$500.

The Auditing Committee reported that everything was good. It was recommended that a guideline be prepared to aid future Auditing Committees. Mr. Kalbian agreed to prepare one.

Nubar Dorian asked the treasurer for a Parish Council presentation of the Financial Report and 1982 Budget. Before giving his report Mr. Kalbian asked Mr. Dorian about our exemption from Diocesan dues this past year because it was our 75th Anniversary. Mr. Dorian explained that he presented it to the Diocesan Committee, and it was rejected.

Mr. Kalbian reported that dues, pledges and plate collections were only up \$1,000 this year. Encouragement of the pledge system is recommended which, along with the interest from the Endowment Fund, could be used to pay Church operating expenses. For 1982, a balanced budget was presented.

Harold Azmelian reported on the \$21,000 budgeted for building improvements. The following items hope to be accomplished:

> Air condition the church. Replace stain glass window frames. Replace Church Center windows. Repair brick coat on outside of Church Center. Install exhaust fan in kitchen. Build à storage closet.

An explanation of the \$2,000 budgeted expense for Seminary donations was given. This is the first time we will be donating to the Seminary in Westchester and Jerusalem. The Diocese is trying to increase the number of priests by activating St. Nersess Seminary in Westchester and supporting the Jerusalem Seminary. Thus having two sources for new priests.

Virginia Shenloogian made a motion to accept the budget. Mike Megerdichian seconded it and the budget was passed.

Old Business: Matilde Kalbian congratulated the Christmas Card committee on making over \$1,000.

New Business

Hagop Hovsepian asked the congregation to support his brother, Archbishop Vatche Hovsepian in the election for Primate of the Eastern Diocese. His name has been placed on the ballot. Virginia Shenloogian made a motion that our Diocesan delegates, Priest and Chairman of the Parish Council vote in favor of Archbishop Vatche Hovsepian. Lud Shahbazian seconded the motion, and it was passed.

A request was made by Mary Nalbandian to have the Church chimes repaired. The company will be contacted again to remedy this.

Grace Genjian made a motion to reduce Parish Council members from eleven to nine. Philip Arpiarian seconded the motion, to be effective in 1983. Following a discussion the motion was voted on and defeated.

Claire Hovsepian suggested that our ACYO join with another Church ACYO. Der Hayr explained that that would not solve the main problem -- full parental cooperation.

Philip Arpiarian made a motion to present to the Diocesan Assembly a change of date of the Annual meeting to March. Charles Kuzujian seconded the motion and it was passed.

CHURCH PICNIC: An opportunity to spend a day with family, friends and fellow parishioners made this a very special occasion. Many thanks to Carnig Shenloogian, Herbert Takakjian and the members of their committees for making the picnic so enjoyable and financially successful.

ANNUAL BAZAAR: Co-Chairpersons Lucy Soovajian, Haig Najarian and their committee did a fine job organizing and running the bazaar. Once again, members of the Women's Guild worked long, hard hours preparing the delicious Armenian ethnic cuisine. The merchandising booths, a rug sale and several raffles added to the festive atmosphere. As in past years, members of the various church organizations volunteered their services in support of the event. PARISH COUNCIL ANNUAL REPORT (cont.)

RUG SALE: Charles Apkarian and Charles Genjian as Co-Chairmen did a splendid job setting up and conducting our church's first full-scale Oriental rug sale. Also contributing greatly to the success of the sale was the late Yenovk Shegerian who supplied rugs and gave us the benefit of his expertise. Mr. Edward Bashian also supplied us with beautiful rugs.

30TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CHURCH CENTER: Our appreciation to Chariman Philip Arpiarian and his committee for working so diligently in planning the dinner and festivities to celebrate the anniversary of our Church Center -- the hub of our cultural and social activities for the past 30 years.

PARISH CHRISTMAS PARTY: Another "first" for our church occurred on December 3 -a Christmas party to which members of the parish were invited. Vivian Hovsepian and Anais Kradjian, Co-Chairmperson along with their committee arranged an extraordinary affair attended by approximately 200 people to celebrate the holiday season. A buffet dinner was prepared by the women; wine, beer and soft drinks were available as well as a band for dancing and entertainment. Because the party was so successful, it looks like the beginning of a new tradition for our church.

CAR RAFFLE: A successful car raffle netting \$15,000 was held on June 12, 1982. This raffle sponsored by the Choir was ably chaired by Lucy Soovajian. We thank her and her committee for a job well done. The proceeds of the affair was earmarked for the installation of air conditioning in the Church.

PLEDGE/ENVELOPE SYSTEM: Offering envelopes were distributed to individuals and families. For the year 1982 a total of \$11,266 were collected via the Pledge/Envelope System. This is an increase over last year and the Pledge Committee is hoping to increase this even more for 1983.

CHURCH RENOVATIONS: The Building-Maintenance Committee headed by Deran Chopoorian and Harold Azmelian did an outstanding job in repairing all of the church properties. According to the plan developed at the beginning of the year, their activities were concentrated on the maintenance of the church center. Storage cabinets were built and new lighting installed in the kitchen area; arrangements were made to purchase a new freezer and to proceed with the installation of a new exhaust system complete with hood in the kitchen.

Another project which was successfully carried out was the air conditioning of the church.

JOINT MEETING WITH CHURCH ORGANIZATIONS: A joint meeting with all the Executive Committees of our church organizations was held on May 20, 1982. This meeting was primarily held for the purpose of coordinating the activities of the organizations and giving an opportunity for each group to present reports of their activities and to ask for help in any areas they feel the Parish Council can aid them. The meeting was mutually supportive to all the groups.

ENDOWMENT FUND: A growing number of parishioners have contributed to our church's endowment fund. A report on the fund by Chairman Lud Shahbazian is included in the annual report booklet.

PERMANENT ENDOWMENT TRUST FUND REPORT

The Holy Cross Church Endowment Fund really closed in on its first goal of \$50,000 in the year 1982. The final figure fell short by only \$3,989.67.

As some of you may remember, your chairman had kept a low profile on the Endowment Fund during the year 1981 which was our 75th Anniversary Year.

The year 1982, however, saw the fund pass the \$40,000 mark early. With further donations down through December 31st, the final figure reached \$46,010.33.

Richard Hachadoorian's donations in the closing months of \$2,000 and \$2,500 respectively in memory of his wife, Anne Hachadoorian, who had served so capably and so dedicatedly for so many years as parish council member and parish council treasurer, gave the fund its biggest lift during 1982. There was also added substantial help from several donors who had pledged yearly donations of \$1,000 and who kept their pledges (listed in the financial report). In addition, donations were received for some new names and several added donations for previously memorialized parishioners who have passed on since Holy Cross's founding back in 1906.

All in all, it was a good year for the Fund which, it may now be safely predicted, will pass the \$50,000 mark in 1983. Once that figure is reached, our sights will be set on the \$100,000 mark!

Remember, the Endowment Fund was actually started back in the 1950's with the donation of \$5,000 from the Estate of Arax Mason and the donation from two parishioners of sotck in Massachusetts Investors Trust Fund and the Public Service Electric & Gas Co. In the next two decades, however, other church projects, such as the renovation of the Sunday School classrooms in the basement, addition of a building to the Church center, and only recently, the complete renovation of the Church Annex, took the spotlight...with the result that the Endowment Fund at the end of 1980 totalled only \$12,500. But it has grown miraculously in the last few years and will in time become an integral part of the financial structure of our church.

Your chairman is heavily indebted to Armen Kalbian and Ann Dadaian for keeping the records of the Fund.

Please do your share! If you want to make a pledge or donation either in a lump sum or in yearly increments in memory of parents or other loved ones who have passed on, do NOT hesitate. Do it NOW!
