




God bless each and everyone of you. I congratulate you and pray for your good health so that you may continue to serve our Lord and our people.

Carnig Hallajian, the Women's Guild has made tremendous progress and has become a dynamic moving force in our parish keeping it more vibrant and alive than ever.

Many new projects were initiated for the continual cultural, social and spiritual nurturing of our Holy Cross family.

The concept of the traditional Mother's Day dinners, which were held on or around Mother's Day, was changed to the Women of the Year dinner. These dinners are held each year on Palm Sunday. As Women of the Year the following were honored 1980-1984: Manoushag Aramian, Rose Sabonjian, Lucy Zulumian, Baidzar Pashayan, Ann Damurjian, Gladys Bagdasarian, Victoria Tukmanian, Nevart Soovajian, Virginia Nishanian, Eleanor Krikorian, Zuvart Serabian, Rose Tamalian, Khatoon Yaldizian, Virginia Shenloogian, Alice Shahinian, Josephine Shahbazian and Ann Dadaian.

The Guild has been holding its monthly meetings on the last Monday night of the month; however, this year meetings were changed to Wednesday afternoons. Annual activities and affairs, such as the Lenten Dinner, Women of the Year Dinner, yearly anniversary celebrations, bazaars and picnics, as well as interesting educational and cultural programs after each meeting are planned. Whenever called upon the Guild is ready and willing to support the Parish. As examples, we prepare the Armenian Christmas breakfast after Holy Badarak on January 6, the raffle drawing cocktail party refreshments, Maundy Thursday luncheon and Parish Annual Meeting luncheon to name a few.

One project which has become a rewarding experience because it invites our Guild to be a part of the community at large, is "Project Share." Baskets, placed in the Church Annex are filled with non-perishable food and other household items. These items are eventually distributed, through the Social Services Department of Hudson County, to needy families with children in the area.

ADVISORS Areknaz Sarajian Alice Foronjy Mary Shalakian Several times a year the Guild visits the Home for the Armenian Aged in Emerson. Choreg and other pastries are prepared and taken to the elderly. They appreciate our visits, and we in return enjoy their company and enthusiasm.

Financially, the Women's Guild has assisted the Church enormously. Our treasury keeps growing in leaps and bounds even though we have generously donated in helping finance major renovations in the Church as well as the Church Center and Church Annex. Our monthly flea markets and the two Rummage Sales held in the Fall and Spring are great fund raisers. We thank all our friends and parishioners for their participation.

One of the truly innovative and invaluable additions to our Guild has been our Newsletter. It contains witty comments, original poetry and news of the Guild as well as the community. The newsletter has become the voice of the Guild disseminating the goals of our organization to our members. It has inspired women and encouraged them to join the Guild and has reached out to those who are unable to attend meetings due to distance or illness.

The Women's Guild has also been involved in activities outside its immediate community. On the Diocesan level we have participated in the One World Festival, have hosted the Armenian Women's Saint's Day in the Cathedral, Strawberry Festival, regional and diocesan level conferences.

We are determined to carry on the work started fifty years ago. . . imagine 50 years! During the pastorate of Very Rev. Mampre Calfayan, who was later to become Primate of the North American Diocese, a group of ladies met at the home of Makroohie Kazazian to lay the groundwork for the present Women's Guild. Also present were Ovsanna Kassabian and Hyganoosh Atashian. On October 11, 1934, the first organizational meeting was formally held at the home of Mrs. Atashian. The 25 women present at this meeting were: Makroohie Kazazian, Hyganoosh Atashian, Ovsanna Kassabian, Lucy Hajeian, Mabel Boyajian, Mooshkenaz Krikorian, Baidzar Tarzian, Mary Shamsey, Azniv Ashjian, Zora Dinkjian, Hyganoosh Shahinian, Yeranig Shaterian, Asdghig Karageosian, Ovsanna Dilberian, Oghida Takakjian, Tuma Froonjian, Manooshag Mgrdichian, Maritza Radoian, Cadar Kaljian, Sara Shamlian, Alice Kurkchian, Mary Soghomonian, Makruhe Nalbandian, Rose Kalfayan and Rose Donchian.

The Ladies Aid, as it was called at that time, elected its first officers: They were: President, Hyganoosh Atashian; Vice President, Baidzar Tarzian; Secretary, Tuma Froonjian; Second Secretary, Alice Kurkchian; Treasurer, Lucy Hajeian; Advisors, Yeranig Shaterian, Asdghig Karageosian, Ovsanna Kassabian and Sara Shamlian.

From the original membership of 25, the Women's Guild has grown into a strong and vigorous organization of 157 members.

Words cannot express our gratitude to all those women who have worked so selflessly throughout these 50 years to keep the spirit of Holy Cross Church alive for our future generations. They have passed the torch to us, and it is up to us to keep their memory ever-burning as we, like they, continue their service and dedication for the perpetuation of our faith and the Holy Cross Church.




