

HOLY CROSS ARMENIAN CHURCH 1988 ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY MEETING February 19, 1989

The annual meeting of the parish of the Holy Cross Armenian Church of Union City was called to order on Sunday, February 19, 1989 at 12:30 p.m. Mr. Armen Kalbian was nominated to serve as Chairman, and Mrs. Claire Hovsepian as Recording Secretary. The meeting was then adjourned for lunch.

The meeting was reconvened at 1:15 p.m. with a total of 51 parishioners in attendance, representing a quorum. Motion was made and seconded to close the ballots at 2:00 p.m.

Prior to the reading of the various organizations' annual reports, Mr. Nubar Dorian gave a verbal report regarding Vehapar's visit to America. Mr. Dorian told us of a meeting with a select group who had met with the Vehapar with the specific purpose of discussing various methods of dealing with the task of aiding and rebuilding after the earthquake in Armenia. The Vehapar mentioned a list of buildings needed for this restoration - i.e., hospitals; schools; orphanages,etc.,and suggested that various organizations should choose one project and undertake the raising of funds to its completion.

There will be no coalition in America. The Central Committee will be in Yerevan. Also, the Soviet Union has agreed to handle the donated monies through Etchmiadzin with a rate of exchange at 4 rubles to \$1.00 (at present, the rate of exchange through a bank is 1.65 rubles to a \$1.00 and the black market rate is 7 rubles to a \$1.00)

To date, there has been collected \$39 million dollars in the United States - and and overall total of \$110 million dollars with Checkslovakia the country with the most monies collected.

It was also pointed out that we do not have a Pastor's report this year and Mr. Dorian stated that hopefully within one months time this matter will be resolved and Holy Cross will have a new spiritual leader.

Philip Arpiarian, Secretary of the Parish Council, asked that the members present read the Parish Council report as submitted and he would be glad to answer any questions. Andy Avedesian made a motion for the report to be accepted as submitted.

Mrs. Julie Borgersen, as a member of the auditing committee, made a brief statement regarding their findings. The committee had reviewed the financial statements of the various organizations and found them to be correct as submitted.

Armen Kalbian then asked Arpena Sbarbaro to say a few words on behalf of the Women's Guild. She thanked all the members for faithfully attending the meetings and for accepting any and all projects that they were assigned. The organization is as strong as ever. At this time, Mrs. Ardemis Koundakjian presented a check in the amount of \$10,000.00 to Harold Azmelian, Treasurer of the Parish Council.

The remainder of the reports as submitted were accepted by those in attendance.

Miss Alice Bozoyan, head of the Sunday School, spoke briefly about the problems regarding the weekly attendance. We only have a total of 10 students, with irregular attendance, and she is faced with a seemingly hopeless situation. Miss Bozoyan asked for guidance from the Parish Council.

After much discussion, Mr. Dorian stated that one of the primary tasks of our new spiritual leader will be to concentrate on resolving these problems (i.e. contacting parents in an effort to increase enrollment; possibly providing some sort of transportation, etc.)

Philip Arpiarian, Secretary of the Parish Council, went over some of the items listed as "new business" in last year's minutes of the Parish meeting. The dinner/dance which was to be held in February was cancelled as a result of the earthquake in Armenia.

Regarding the purchase of a new organ for Holy Cross Church, Ms Mary Shalakian reported that she had contacted the people at Rogers and went over the type that would suit our church and the cost would be between \$10 and \$15, "thousand dollars. It was suggested that Ms.Shalakian form a committee and present a plan of action for raising this money to the Parish Council for them to put into motion.

New Business

1. Donation to St. Nerses Seminary

Philip Arpiarian made a motion to appropriate an additional \$1500.00 donation to the St. Nerses Seminary. It was pointed out that Fr.Carnig Hallajian has never accepted any compensation for his services to our Church and this additional \$1500, be made to St.Nerses in his name accompanied by a letter formally thanking Fr.Hallajian.

Vote was called and passed 21-10 in favor.

2. A recommendation was made Parish Council reports and the Vision be printed both in English and Armenian. Ms.Yigitkurt will contact someone who has a knowledge of the use of our Armenian typewriter and Mr. Dorian volunteered to submit articles in Armenian to be printed in the Vision.

3. Apo Boghosian made a motion that a theater group be formed as another form of fund raising. Parish Council will work on organizing a group and selecting a director. Passed unanimously.

Discussion of 1989 proposed annual budget was reviewed by 4. Harold Azmelian. Approval needed for: (a) Building maintenance and improvements

- (b) Renovation of entrance to Parish house.
- (c) Office machinery it was proposed that we purchase a new copy machine which could be used for printing the Vision, the Sunday bulletin, etc.
- (d) Maintain Holy Cross yearly contribution to St. Nerses Seminary at the \$3,000.00 figure.

A vote of acceptance by those in attendance was requested 5. for the painting and cleaning of the interior of the Church. also installing a new awning for the entrance to the Parish House, since the cost will exceed \$500.00. Parish Assembly Minutes Page #3

Motion was made and seconded to approve this renovation work and passed unanimously.

Zaven Hovsepian proposed returning the sum of \$10,261.35 to the Trust Fund which was originally borrowed from the interest earned on this fund. Seconded by R.Borgersen and unanimously passed.

Mr. Philip Arpiarian, announced the results of the elections as follows:

A total of 51 votes were cast.

General Discussion

Mary Shalakian asked the Parish Council to look into the sale of the building on 27th Street and New York Avenue for possible use as a parking garage for the Parishioners. They agreed to investigate and advise us.

Mr. Hagop Hovsepian also expressed his appreciation of the fact that we have always had a visiting Clergy on Sunday and everything has been running smoothly and our parish remains as strong as ever, thanks to our faithful parishioners.. Also, Mr. Arpiarian commended Mrs.Sbarbop for her efforts towards this end.

The matter of acquiring a new staff (kafazan) for our church was proposed and Mr. Hrant Gulian kindly advised that he would take care of getting Holy Cross a new staff for use by visiting high ranking clergy.

At this point, Mr. Nubar Đorian congratulted the new council members and thanked Armen Kalbian for chairing the meeting.

1989

The Parish Council of the Holy Cross Church met ten times during the calendar year 1989. Following th Annual Parish Assembly, the Parish Annual Report was submitted to the Diocese. Confirmation of the election of new Parish Council members was received in April 1989.

<u>ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY 1988</u> - During the meeting the parishioners passed several motions regarding church activities. The Parish took action as indicated.

- a. <u>Church Organ</u>- Miss Mary Shalakian was appointed as the Chairperson of the organ committee. To date over \$10,000 has been collected. A meeting was held with a representative of the organ manufacturers to determine the location, number of speakers and the disposition of old organs.
- b. <u>St. Nersess Seminary</u> A motion was paded to increase the Holy Cross contribution to the St. Nersess Seminary to \$3,000. The funds were forwarded in December. The Holy Cross Church has benefited greatly by having students, Gregory Doudoukjian and Richard Bohajian serving on the Altar during the Holy Badarak.

- c. <u>Vision/Annual Report</u> As requested, the VISION now has articles in both English and Armenian. This year's Annual Report also includes reports of Parish activities in Armenian.
- d. <u>Theater Groups</u> The motion to form a theater group was not acted upon by the Parish Council.
- e. <u>New Kavazan (Staff)</u> With the help of Hrant Gulian and Deacon Hagop Hovsepian a new staff was bought and is kept on the altar for use by visiting clergy.

PARISH PRIEST Since of August of 1988 our parish has been functioning (successfully) without the benefit of a Parish Priest. During this period, the parishiners have been very patient and supportive of the Parish Council. The Search Committee for a new priest has petitioned the Primate to find a replacement. The committee made contact with two acceptable candidates who after several meetings declined the opportunity to serve at Holy Cross. As an interim measure the Search Committee reached an agreement with Father Carnig Hallajian whereby he would conduct the Holy Badarak at least 26 times during the year and would assist in the publication of the VISION and attend Parish Council meetings (schedule permitting).

Because of the efforts of Arpena Sbarbaro our church has been fortunate in that there has been a priest present each Sunday to conduct the Holy Badarak, and provide services for weddings, funerals and christenings as needed.

STEWARDSHIP/PLEDGES - In 1989, sixty-three individuals/families made weekly contributions using the offering envelopes. This year \$7,521 (\$7,667 in 1988) was received. All parishioners have received correspondence regarding the pledge system and weekly offering envelopes have been distibuted. Pledging is important in that it provides the Parish Council with an indication of income which is needed to plan expenditures. Using weekly offering envelopes provides the parishioners with a means (and a reminder) to give regularly, thus providing a steady income to the Church during the year. The Parish Council is planning on providing quarterly reports to those who have pledged for 1990. Your support in this endeavor would greatly be appreciated.

<u>PICNIC</u>, <u>BAZAAR</u>, <u>RAFFLE</u> As in the past, these functions have helped generate a significant amount of income for the Church. The chairpersons and their committees asre to be commended for their efforts.

DINNER DANCE - In 1989 a new function was included in the Parish activities ---- A Dinner Dance. Co-chairmed by Apo Boghossian and Alice Yigitkurt, a dance was held in Atlantic City. Two hundred people were in attendance and a good time was had by all. The proceeds from this affair and those held in the coming year are earmarked for the parking project fund.

PARISH COUNCIL REPORT (cont.)

<u>PARKING</u> - Parking has always been a major issue in our Church. In 1989 a committee was formed consisting of Apraham Boghossian and Harold Azmelian to investigate ways and means of providing parking facilities for the parishioners. Various options were reviewed - buying property or possibly rebuilding the church center with parking underneath. The process requires funds to develop plans. As indicated previously, these funds are represented by the proceeds from the Dinner Dance.

<u>CHURCH PROPERTY</u> - Last year the authorization was made to expend \$20,000 for church property repairs and for new equipment. Under the able and conscientious direction of Harold Azmelian, the following major repairs were made: new roof over the stage at the church center, the painting of the church interior (washing walls and refinishing pews), new awning at entrance to the parish house and renovations to the third floor of the parish house. Other miscellaneous repairs included the refrigerator (annex) plumbing and the air conditioning equipment. Plans for next year (if approved) include renovations in the back room of the church office and the purchase f of new office equipment (folding machine).
