Income: There is a registration fee of \$15 per student. If there is more than one child in a family attending, each additional child pays \$10. One of the teachers is paid \$15.00 per week.

Affairs: The students presented a program for the Knights of Vartan Christmas party; also presented a program at the Home for the Armenian Aged; participated in program for the anniversary dinner; and closing exercises. The students went to the Fair Lawn church; participated in picnic for all Armenian school students in New Jersey.

Plans for coming year: Presentation of Armenian play; Armenian movie; Annual Hantes - and most of all "To make the St. Thomas Armenian School the NO. 1 School" and to multiply the number of students we now have.

We foresee for the academic year 1970-71 a budget of \$2,000 to cover the expenses of teachers, school supplies and teaching aids. For the remainder of this year, we will need from \$200-\$250 to cover expenses of school supplies, teaching aids, preparation for the annual hantes and weekly refreshments.
