

SUNDAY SCHOOL REPORT

September 1973 - June 1974

Registration for Sunday School was held on the third Sunday in September. 161 students were registered. We had a staff of 11 teachers, 3 substitutes, and 3 administrative assistants.

Classes received Communion on a rotating basis from October through December. Mrs. Rose Garjian and Mrs. Rosemary Soovajian, with the help of the class mothers, provided the light breakfast for the children after Communion.

In October we held a "Pot Luck Supper" which was quite successful. Many thanks to our Social Staff members who worked very hard on this project.

Our Christmas party was held on December 16th immediately after classes. We served a light lunch followed by varied activities by the children. There was a large turnout, and we had a most enjoyable time. The Christmas Communion took place on January 6, 1974. Easter Communion was on April 13, 1974. It was highlighted by an Easter egg hunt.

The Sunday School held a very successful Palm Sunday Dinner. A chicken dinner was served, and afterwards a program was presented. The children who had maintained a perfect attendance record throughout the entire Lenten period were rewarded with a chocolate bunny.

During the Spring, Yeretzgin Violet Kasparian and Mrs. Rollin Mateosian attended a seminar for Sunday School teachers. It was held at the Cathedral in New York. The main topic of this seminar dealt with the use of audio visual aids in teaching as a supplement in educating the children. Both of our representatives found it very interesting, and the entire staff benefited by their having attended.

On June 9th, closing ceremonies were held. There were three graduates this semester. There were very few because of a new policy adopted by the staff which makes it necessary for 10th grade pupils to meet certain requirements. The three pupils who did graduate met those requirements. At this time the students with good attendance records were given their pins.

We look back on the 1973-74 season as a very successful year. Once again the entire staff met their tasks with dedication and enthusiasm. We thank them.
