MINUTES OF ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY OF ST. THOMAS ARMENIAN CHURCH FIRST SESSION - SUNDAY, JANUARY 27, 1985

Mr. George Mekenian opened the meeting at 12:02 p.m. Victor Arzoomanian moved, and Alyce Parseghian seconded, to waive the minutes of last year's assembly. The slate of officers for nomination to the Parish Council, Nominating Committee, Auditors and Assembly Officers was read by Mr. Arzoomanian, Chairman of the Nominating Committee. - .Yeretzgin asked that delegates to the Diocesan Assembly
 - a. support funding fornew Sunday School curriculum,
 - b. request that the meetings of delegates of theWomen's Guilds, Sunday Schools, Armenian Schools and ACYOA not be held concurrently with the Diocesan Assembly. This would permit delegates to concentrate on the Assembly.
- .Peter Ajemian noted the need to upgrade the budget for building funds (Mr. Mekenian noted that it would be covered under old business.)

Mr. Arzoomanian made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Nish Ohanessian. The Chair asked that the motion be amended to read that the second session would convene after lunch next Sunday in the Church. The motion was carried.
