

ANNUAL REPORT
Young Women's Auxiliary of the
Armenian Holy Trinity Church of Greater Boston
June, 1967 - Jan. 1968

The following information is taken from the books and records of the recording secretary from June, 1967 through Jan. 1968.

A bake sale was held on June 1, 1967 with a profit of \$139.00. On this date the cookbook was introduced for sale and sales for that day totaled \$95.00. Eight hundred cookbooks in all were printed and will be sold at various functions throughout the years.

The June 21, 1967 meeting had an installation of new officers:

It was reported that the Cotillion Committee has 7 debutantes sponsored to date and 36 ushers. 480 tickets for the event have been sold and the sponsor book made a profit of \$2,535.00.

Mary Skenian, chairman of the Bazaar reported that everything was going smoothly and that the Trinity Men's Union would take over the Midway.

It was announced at the September meeting that Queenie Antonucci had been in an auto accident and Ann Tashjian had an operation, leaving both on the sick list.

A successful rummage sale run by Carol Zeytoonjian was held on October 20, 21, 1967 at Cultural Hall. Another is being planned for next April, 1968.

It was announced that in donating flowers on the altar in memory of deceased persons, we should contact Esther Jamgoshian.

Ann Hintlian ran a Beano Party at the home of Nancy Kasarjian on October 25, 1967 in order to raise money for the Bazaar dinner.

The Young Women's Auxiliary pledged \$100.00 towards the Anniversary Banquet.

A keyma and card party was held on October 11, 1967 with a profit of \$240.55 to go toward the Bazaar funds.

We were sorry to hear of the death of Marguerite Goshgarian's father and Veronica Parechan's mother. Also Arax Najarian's father, and the death of Gen. Zartarian. Donations to the church in lieu of flowers were sent in their memory.

Two new members were introduced at the November meeting: Mrs. Margaret Tungate and Mrs. Ann Janigian.

A letter from Morgan Memorial was received thanking us for articles of clothing sent to them from our rummage sale.

Mary Hintlian, Betty Asadourian and Melanie Martin went to the Worcester Bazaar and took 25 cookbooks for them to sell.

Miss Anna Yeshilian was guest speaker at the November meeting and she spoke of her trip to Yerivan, Armenia and Russia.

The sixth cotillion was held on Nov. 26, 1967 at the Statler Hilton under the chairmanship of Betty Asadourian. Our annual Christmas Bazaar was held on Dec. 2, 1967 with Mary Skenian as chairman and we are happy to report both events were a huge success.

We are again sponsoring an Armenian orphan in Armenia through the efforts of Estella Arzoomanian.

Mrs. Gostigian, who won the TV in the Bazaar raffle donated a check for \$100.00 to the church but this check has not as yet been received or recorded to our accounts and this matter will be looked into.

Our accounts are to be transferred to another bank in the Fresh Pond area since parking facilities are so difficult at Harvard Square.

The Social Services Committee sent a fruit basket to Sally Semenza and a gift of money to two needy families. We also donated a gift of \$25.00 for the Armenian School and we purchased two wreaths for the front doors of the church for the Christmas season.

Plans for the future include a visit to the Old Age Home. A night out for dinner and play in Boston is again in the planning stage.

As of Jan. 4, 1968 the treasurer reported a balance of \$17,781.65. Deductions have not been made yet for expenses of Bazaar and Cotillion.

The children received Communion on Saturday morning Jan. 6, 1968 and were served breakfast by the Sunday School Committee.
