### ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 5, 1984

The Annual Parish Assembly of the Holy Trinity Armenian Apostolic Church in Cambridge, Massachusetts, was held on Sunday, February 5, 1984, following a luncheon, in the Cultural Hall, with the Pastor, Reverend Mampre Kouzouian presiding. The opening prayer was given by the Pastor.

The meeting was called to order by Stephen Panosian, Parish Council Chairman at 1:30 p.m. One hundred seventy-five (175) dues paying members were present and voted.

Mr. Donald Tellalian, Chairman of the Nominating Committee, conducted the election of the day's Tivan. The following were elected:

Mr. Tashjian called for the reading of the Secretary's report for the 1983 Parish Assembly. A motion was made and seconded to accept the secretary's report as presented without a formal reading. He also called upon Donald Tellalian to read the slate as put forward by the Nominating Committee, and then open the floor for additonal nominees. It was also requested that the nominees come forward to identify themselves for the benefit of the voting members.

Motion was made and seconded to close nominations. There was a request from Charles Garabedian to have his name withdrawn from the list of nominees because of professional commitments.

The voting opened and a recess was called for the members to cast their ballots. After a 15 minute recess, the meeting reconvened at 2:00 p.m., and the ballot box remained open until 2:30 p.m.

Reverend Kouzouian felt that it was unnecessary to read the entire report, but he wished to read specific sections of the report to emphasize their importance. A motion was made and seconded for this report to be accepted.

### Parish Council's Activities and Financial Report:

It was decided that since everyone had previously read the Parish Council Report, it would not be read at this meeting, but Mr. Stephen Panosian, the Parish Council Chairman wanted to emphasize the following points: The importance of the Stewardship Program and its positive progress, the sadness at the loss of Parish Council member, Joseph Haroutunian, and the successful banquet honoring the 20th Anniversary Celebration of His Eminence, Archbishop Torkom Manoogian. He also spoke of the needed improvements in the area of maintenance to our Church, and brought out the fact that although we no longer housed the French School, we are currently renting the facilities to the Apple School which will help the budget. He asked if there were any questions. There were none, and a motion was made and seconded to accept the Parish Council report as written.

Gregory Krikorian, Parish Council Treasurer, was then asked to give the Financial Report. Mr. Krikorian asked if there were any questions about the financial report. A question was asked whether the Apple School rental figure of \$6,500 was for one-half year or was it a yearly rental. Mr. Krikorian stated that it was through April of 1983. A question was raised as to "prayers" under Miscellaneous Income on page 6c in the amount of \$137.00, and to what did this refer. Mr. Krikorian explained this was donated by individuals who wanted prayers of "Der Voghormia". Another question was raised under Disbursements. A parishioner wanted to know why the Donations figure jumped from \$200 in 1982 to \$1,000 in 1983. It was explained that \$500 was donated at the banquet for the Arachnort and that \$200 and then \$300 was donated to St. Marks Church in Springfield, MA. It was also asked why the travel expense jumped from \$300 in 1982 to \$900 in It was explained that 1982's meeting was in Hartford to which many of the 1983. delegates drove their cars, but that the 1983 meeting was in Chicago which entailed air fares. A question was asked why the Apple School rental was less than the rental had been for the French School in the past. It was explained that the Apple School rental was less because they rented less space, but they would be anticipating an expansion in the near furture, and hopefully we would restore the rental picutre to at least the previous amounts.

Another question was brought forth about clergy preparation of \$5,000. It was explained that every church was assessed by the Diocese as to its due which was 2% of the annual income of the church.

A point of information was brought up that the Diocesan dues of \$35,828.00 was determined by the following criteria:

- 1. Membership 4. Sacraments 2.
  - Number of clergy 5. Delegates
- 3. Income

A question was raised as to why there was a \$19,000 increase under Salaries. It was explained that the increase was due to the addition of a Youth Director, an additional bookkeeper and an additional custodian.

A question was asked as to why the stipends were not broken down. It was explained that the figures are available if anyone should like to see them. The Chairman advised that this point had to be discussed under "New Business". A question was raised as to the transfer to Reserve Savings of moneys. It was explained that all interest money received from certificates of deposit went into savings.

A question was asked as to the whereabouts of the \$10,000 given in November by Isaac Karchakian. It was explained that it was in the Trust Fund in a bank as we only receive interest for that money.

Another question was brought forth as to the difference of the 1983 disbursement proposal of \$346,000 as against this year's \$310,000 disbursement. It was explained that last year proposed disbursement was \$318,000 and we came in at \$311,000. Question was raised as to what was the "insurance claim." It was explained that these were monies reflected from the income derived from the insurance company for the rugs that were stolen from the church. Another question was brought out as to why "miscellaneous services paid by parishioners" is listed under payments made by church. It was explained that these monies are paid to the church and the church pays it out, that is how it works and that is why it is listed. A question was raised if anyone gave the church a "set figure" on oil. It was explained that an average was taken for the last few years in order to arrive at a projection, but it was felt that the cost of oil should be higher because oil is going up and the projection was low.

A motion was then made and seconded to accept the Financial Report and 1984 Proposed Budget as written.

George D. Hagopian was asked to come forth to explain the Trust Fund. He noted that there was a correction on Page 7 of the Cash on Hand which read \$405,522.70 should now read \$405, 522.90. He explained that pages 7, 7a and 7b were a recap, as to what had transpired during the current year and that 7a and 7b was a breakdown of all contributions since the fund started. Mr. Hagopian stated that the funds established could not be touched for the first ten years, and at the end of the ten years, the income could be used to operate the church. A question was asked if Trust Fund donations were primarily money or were there securities. Mr. Hagopian responded that we had no securities or stocks or bonds.

Motion was made and seconded to accept the Trust Fund and Gifts Report 1975 thru 1983 as written.

At this time, Chairman Tashjian called for the reports from the various Church Organizations. The Stewardship Chairman, Haig Hedison, said the report was self-explanatory but the Stewardship Program was improving every year. He asked if there were any questions? A question was asked as to how many new members we obtained in 1983. Mr. Hedison answered 40 or 50 new members, but the total was offset by the deceased. A question was asked if the amounts given could be listed by families to help to possibly raise the total and what was the average amount given per family unit. He explained the average money given per family unit was \$200. Mr. Hediosn also pointed out that the computer would now be of great help to retrieve further information.

Cultural Committee Chairman was called to report but was not present. It was asked if there were any questions? There were no questions but there was a vote of appreciation by several parishioners for the work done by the Cultural Committee.

Erevan Choral Society Report was given by Zabel Odabashian who stated that this year's concert was to be commemorated to the Martyrs and that the concert had a membership of about 50 people. Mrs. Zabel Odabashian presented the Choir report on page F. Mr. Aetna Tashjian, before calling the Senior Women's Guild to give their report, thanked them for a splendid luncheon. The Senior Women's Guild Report was given by Mrs. Rose Sargavakian.

Helen Donabedian asked that minutes by the Chelsea Women's Auxiliary be accepted as written.

The Lynn, Salem, Peabody Ladies Auxiliary Chairman was not present and there was no comment about the report.

Women's Guild Chairman, Margaret Atamian, felt report was self-explanatory, but mention was made of a May 19 Operetta, and that tickets were now being dispersed.

Holy Trinity Men's Union report was accepted as presented. At this point, Mr. Albert Oskoian brought out that all the TMU does is have a good time and he felt that Parish Council members should be aware of this and take more of an interest. Alex Ashjian felt the TMU does patronize the church financially and that they also have speakers. A question was brought up that if the 1000 Club is run by the TMU, why aren't the people who are running it and working at it, members of the TMU. It was brought out that before only the committee members did everything and that they would ask other organizations to help. It was felt that the executive committee of the 1000 Club should be members of the TMU, otherwise why do they get credit when other people do the work.

Armenian School reported that because of declining enrollment it was decided to stop Saturday School and have it Sunday morning. 40 to 50 students enrolled. These students were divided into 3 groups and the hours were from 10:00 to 10:30. The curriculum was mostly speaking and History, but also writing of characters of the alphabet were added. Perhaps they would go back to Saturday if the enrollment continued to increase.

Church School Report given by Deacon Richard Abdalian. He reported that a new curriculum was being prepared by the Diocese and will be implemented by Holy Trinity as a pilot program, and hopefully will be used by all the churches. There were 115 students, but attendance declined the last few months, and he encouraged parents to bring the children. He asked if there were any questions. There were none.

ACYOA Seniors report presented by Alexan Kouzouian. He stated that they had 35 young people but that only 12 were active members. He also mentioned that delegates were sent to Sports Weekend in Toronto.

ACYOA Juniors report was presented by Lisa Stephanian. She gave a list of activites to come and reviewed the report.

Youth Director, Deacon Richard Abdalian presented his report and read the second paragraph. He asked if there were any questions. There were none.

#### New Business:

Nishan Mootafian felt that totals that were lumped should be broken down. He felt that stipends should be broken down in the annual report. He asked if Parish Council considered this in the past. Parish Council Chairman said this information was available to every member who can go to the church and get that information, but it was not printed as such in official documentation. Nishan Mootafian made a motion that stipends be broken down and reported individually in the annual report. Discussion ensued as to whether the Parish Council decides if the stipends were reported in a lump sum. It was stated that the Parish Council votes on raises and salaries and then the total was published because they felt it was proprietory information which should be available only to parish members. A vote was taken on the motion as to whether there should be a breakdown of stipends in the annual report. 24 were in favor of the breakdown, and 42 were opposed and the motion was defeated.

Albert Oskoian made a motion for a wireless microphone so people can speak from audience more freely. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Albert Oskoian made a motion that the Christmas Bazaar be moved back to the first Saturday of December. Anita Hedison said this year's Bazaar was too close to the Rug Sale and it was difficult for those who work on the same committee. Some brought out that it was more festive in December and some brought out that the weather was better in November. Nancy Kasarjian said 1983 attendance was slightly less. Motion was passed that the Bazaar be moved back to the first Saturday in December.

Albert Oskoian asked if the By-law booklets were available to be purchased. The Chairman informed him they were available at the Diocese and also at our own Church office for five dollars.

Arthur Panosian brought up the fact that we have 50 feet of cable that could be placed in the middle of the floor istead of purchasing the wireless microphone Chairman stated that the motion for wireless microphone had already passed. It was also brought up that the motor for jack in center was not working, but "wireless microphone" meant something that could be available to the group of people. The Chairman of the Parish Council said he would look into this matter.

Zabel Odabashian said that the Christmas Concert has become an annual event and that risers should be purchased instead of going every year to get them. She recommended portable risers. Stephen Panosian said requisition should be made to Parish Council and they would look into it. The motion was withdrawn since it was not seconded.

Marge Atamian made a motion that in the future, the sample ballots mailed out prior to election sstate the length of the term of office of the delegate. This was not made clear in this year's sample ballot. Motion was seconded and passed.

Albert Oskoian wanted to know how far along we were on plans for the Martyrs Memorial monument. Archie Kolligian, Chairman for that project, said he has discussed this with Reverend Kouzouian and Reverend Maksoudian, and he felt that each time there were other events that took precedence. They do feel that they will continue to work on this project as they would very much like to have a monument ready for the 70th Anniversary of the martyrs. Chairman for this project said that all contributions are being accepted for this project and that the cost was estimated to be 65-75 thousand dollars. Reverend Kouzouian said that this had to be left open so that they could judge when artists came forth with plans and figures. He said the information would be available as soon as decisions were made.

Rose Tikijian asked if a Diocesan Delegate's term was 4 years, how long could he or she serve? Chairman answered there was no limit.

Question was brought out about absentee ballots for those who could not be present. It was brought out by Reverend Kouzouian that this motion was submitted to Proposal Committee and it missed the deadline for presentation and it was resubmitted on January 24th to the Diocesan Proposal Committee.

A motion was made by Marge Atamian that a Diocesan delegate should have been first a member of the parish council, and served at least one term as a trustee. Motion was made and seconded and a vote was taken. Vote was 41 for and 26 against. The motion was then slated to be carried to the Diocesan level. A motion was made that the term of a Diocesan delegate (which is 4 years) be only 2 consecutive terms, and then they must be replaced. A vote was taken and the motion was defeated. This was the end of new business.

Reverend Kouzouian then gave thanks to the outgoing members of the Parish Council. He then congratulated the newly elected officers, who were as follows:

### HOLY TRINITY ARMENIAN APOSTOLIC CHURCH PASTOR'S ANNUAL REPORT FOR 1984 REVEREND FATHER MAMPRE KOUZOUIAN

#### Dear Parishioners:

I herewith submit my Eighth Annual Report for the Year 1984. I give thanks to Almighty God for giving me the health to work with you for another year as your Pastor. I will divide my pastoral activities in the following categories:

#### I. Church Services

As in the past, Church Services were conducted every Sunday and on special occasions with sermons delivered in both languages. During the Church Services, the Reverend Father Papken Maksoudian and the Very Rev. Oshagan Minasian have assisted me together with Altar Servers and Choir Members.

On various occasions, the pastor emeritus has conducted the Divine Liturgy and delivered the sermon.

During 1984, the following clergy have conducted Services in our Church, delivered the sermon or visited our community:

- On January 29th, the Very Reverend Father Arshen Ayvazian celebrated the Divine Liturgy and delivered the sermon.
- On Sunday, March 18th, His Grace Bishop Papken Varjabedian, Legate of the Diocese in Washington, D.C. delivered the sermon.
- On Sunday, May 20th, the Very Reverend Momig Sarkissian, a member of the Brotherhood of Holy Etchmiadzin, celebrated and delivered the sermon.
- On May 27th, Father Arten Ashjian, Canon Sacrist of St. Vartan Cathedral, celebrated and delivered the sermon.
- On June 3, the Very Reverend Baret Yeretzian, Pastor of the Holy Cross Church of Lawrence, celebrated and delivered the sermon.
- On June 23-24th, His Eminence the Primate, celebrated the Divine Liturgy, delivered the sermon, and conducted the Ordination Service.

- On July 24, Bishop Yeghishe Gizirian, Primate of the Armenian Church of London, visited our community.
- On July 29th, Father Barkev Bardakjian from Lebanon, participated in the Divine Liturgy.
- On August 5th, Father Tateos Abdalian celebrated and delivered the sermon. Father Garabed Kochakian of Racine, Wisc. took part in the Services.
- On Sunday, August 12, Father Arshen Aivazian took part in the Blessing of the Grapes Service.
- On Sunday, August 19th, Bishop Kevork Saraydarian, Primate of the Armenian Church of Georgia, celebrated the Divine Liturgy and delivered the sermon.
- On August 26th, Bishop Kuid Nakashian, Primate of the Armenian Church in Paris, France, celebrated and delivered the sermon.
- On November 6th, Bishop Aghan Baliozian, Primate of the Armenian Church of Australia, visited our community.

During the first two Sundays of March, I celebrated in the Armenian Church of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. On May 27th, at St. Vartan Cathedral of New York City. On July 3, at the Holy Cross Church of Lawrence, MA. On Saturday, December 15th, I celebrated for the Armenian community of Cape Cod.

During Lent, Holy Week, and Special Feast Days, we conducted Church Services for the members of the community.

I wish to express my appreciation to our Altar Servicers, to the members of our Choir, and to our organist for their dedicated services to our Church. May God reward them abundantly.

II. Sacraments and Services

During 1984, the following sacraments and services were conducted in our Church:

Baptisms = 19 Engagements = 2 Weddings = 14 Funerals = 38

I have been with our parishioners on these occasions to console them, to counsel them, and partake in their grief or joy.

### III. Counseling Services

On 56 occasions, I have had counseling sessions with individuals and families. I also had premarital counseling sessions with people who were preparing for marriage. I also had pre-confirmation counseling with adults and with individuals who had personal problems.

#### IV. Pastoral Visitations

During the past year, I made 359 pastoral visitations to the homes of our parishioners, to hospitals, nursing homes, and offices. On various occasions, I have visited cemeteries to bless the graves of deceased parishioners. I have visited the Armenian Nursing Home on several occasions.

As an outreach service of our Church, every week I have made calls to our elderly parishioners, the sick and shut-ins, to show our interest in their welfare. I have done the same prior to high holidays. These calls and visitations have been appreciated by our parishioners.

#### V. Meetings

I have participated and was present at 331 meetings during 1984. Of these meetings, 288 have been with parish-affiliated organizations or their executive bodies, or with individuals, and the remainder with different committees in our region or the Diocesan level. I have also participated in the Annual Diocesan Assembly held during the first weekend of May in St. Leon's Armenian Church of Fairlawn, N.J. I have chaired the monthly Diocesan Council Meetings, the Diocesan Regional Conferences, and participated in the unity dialogue with a dissident church within our Diocese. I have been a member of the Board of Directors of St. Nersess Seminary and the ACEF Board of our Diocese.

#### VI. Cultural and Educational

Through the efforts of our Cultural Committee, we have provided outstanding cultural programs to our parishioners and neighbors during the month of October. The month-long cultural programs may be reviewed in the Cultural Committee's report. In December, we had the Holy Trinity Christmas Concert; in April during the Martyrs' Day Commemoration at the State House, we provided speakers from the Armenian community. This year's speaker were Dr. James Etmekjian, and James Kalustian representing the youth.

We express our gratitude to our Armenian and Sunday School superintendents and teachers for their dedicated services. May God bless our teachers for their dedication. On various occasions, I have utilized the monthly meetings of our Church-affiliated organizations to speak to them on various subjects. The Dajar, monthly publication of our parish, has also been utilized for this purpose.

### VII. Youth Ministry

During the first half of 1984, Deacon Richard Abdalian served as our youth director. Richard left his position after his ordination to the priesthood. From September to the end of this year, we engaged the services of Kenneth Maranian as Sunday School Superintendent and Mark McKertich as Youth Director. On many occasions, I had meetings with Deacon Richard, Kenny and Mark to plan for our children's Christian education and the youth of our parish. On a few occasions the Armenian students of the neighboring universities have been our guests at our Center for socials and fellowship.

### VIII. Important Events

- On June 23-24th, His Eminence Archbishop Torkom Manoogian, Primate of our Diocese, visited our community to ordain Deacon Richard Abdalian as a priest of the Armenian Church. On Saturday afternoon, His Eminence had a dinner-meeting with the members of our Parish Council and our Diocesan delegates. During the evening, he conducted the Services of "Calling to the Priesthood" of Deacon Richard. On Sunday, June 24th, during the Divine Liturgy, he ordained and consecrated Deacon Richard as a priest of the Armenian Church and thereby named him Father Tateos.
- On June 22nd, with His Eminence Archbishop Torkom Manoogian, our Primate, and a group of Armenian clergymen from our region, we paid a curtesy call on His Excellency Archbishop Bernard Law, the new Archbishop of the Roman Catholic Church of Boston, to welcome him to Boston.
- Since the last Diocesan Assembly, a pilot program of regionalization of our parishes has been experimental in our Diocese, the first such pilot program for the New England Region. Since our church is located in the New England Area we have new responsibilities and commitments to our New England regional Vicar who is the Very Reverend Baret Yeretzian.
- On October 14th during our Anniversary Banquet, our parish honored Aram Hintlian as Man of the Year.

### IX. Visit to Holy Etchmiadzin

From June 25 through July 8th, with three Diocesan Council members, I accompanied the Primates of our Diocese and the Western Diocese, to have an audience with His Holiness, the Catholicos of All Armenians and to submit for his consideration, various important issues facing our Diocese. I am happy that our mission was accomplished with the blessings of the Spiritual Father of our Church.

During our stay in Holy Etchmiadzin, we were the guests of His Holiness. On this occasion, we made several pilgrimages to different Holy Shrines in Armenia.

#### X. Church Office

We have kept our office open from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Mondays through Fridays. The pastor, pastor emeritus, our secretary Rose Mamishian, and bookkeeper Harvinder Jassal handle the office work. A group of parishioners and friends often volunteer their services to the office to whom we express our gratitude. I would like to specifically express my appreciation to our Church secretary Rose Mamishian, for her dedication, and to our volunteers.

#### XI. Appreciation

My appreciation is extended to our pastor emeritus, Rev. Father Papken Maksoudian, for his help in carrying on my ministry in our parish. Also to Father Oshagan Minasian for his services. I would like to express my appreciation to the chairman of our Parish Council, Stephen Panosian, to the Tivan and the members of the Parish Council for their dedication and leadership.

I thank all our parishioners for their prayers, and support, and their contributions made to our Church. May God reward you all with his blessings.

In the annals of Parish Council Reports, the year 1984 proved to be one of the most successful, both socially and financially.

On April 27, 1984, the commemoration of the Armenian Genocide was held at the State House in Boston. Distinguished guests were Michael Dukakis, Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and George Keverian, now Speaker of the House of Representatives. Among the speakers for this occasion were Dr. James Etmekjian and James Kalustian. Arpie Kouzouian was soloist and her rendition appropriate Armenian songs was noteworthy.

A joint meeting of the Parish Councils and Diocesan Delegates of our Church and St. James Armenian Church took place in Johnson Hall. This meeting proved to be productive and among the items placed on the Agenda were: Jointly sponsored events commemorating the 70th Anniversary of the Armenian Genocide, progress of the Regionalization Plan and joint ventures in sponsoring Armenian artists of high calibre.

On Sunday, May 20, 1984, our Church was honored in having as Celebrant of the Divine Liturgy, Reverend Father Momig Sarkesian from Holy Etchmiadzin.

On Sunday, June 24, 1984, Deacon Richard Abdalian was ordained as a Priest of the Armenian Church. His Eminence, Archbishop Torkom Manoogian, Primate of the Eastern Diocese of the United States officiated. On the Saturday preceding the ordination, a Calling to the Priesthood ceremony took place and at both ceremonies, our Church was filled to capacity. Following the ordination, a banquet was held in Cultural Hall in honor of the newly ordained Reverend Father Tateos Abdalian. Gregory Krikorian was Chairman of the Banquet which was attended by approximately 450 parishioners and friends.

Our Church again was honored by having His Grace, Bishop Kevork Saraydarian, a member of the Holy Brotherhood of Etchmiadzin, Celebrant of the Divine Liturgy on Sunday, August 19, 1984.

In September, 1984 roofs of the Parish Council office and the Bridal Room were repaired, an emergency which was promptly resolved. Other roofs will be taken care of in 1985. It is of interest to note that Aetna Tashjian, Chairman of the Maintenance Committee, is studying and working on a fiveyear plan for maintenance of our Church properties.

The Annual Picnic with Bruce Haroutunian as Chairman took place on an ideal day, September 9, 1984. The grounds of St. Vartanantz Armenian Church in Chelmsford was the scene of happy parishioners and friends enjoying a day of group dancing, entertainment and delicious foods.

The 23rd Anniversary of the Consecration of our Church was observed on Sunday, October 14, 1984. This was also designated as Stewardship Sunday. Following the Divine Liturgy, a Banquet was held in Cultural Hall at which time Aram Hintlian, a worker and benefactor of our Church, was honored as Man of the Year. Rose Minassian was Chairman of the Banquet and Arthur Panosian served as Master of Ceremonies. The meal was prepared by members of the Senior Women's Guild. Our appreciation is extended to Mr. and Mrs. Gerald Ajemian who underwrote the Banquet.

A successful Rug Sale was held on November 1, 2, 3 and 4, 1984 of which Nancy Kasarjian served as Chairman. Despite some obstacles, this sale netted approximately \$40,000.00. The firm of Robert Proodian and Sons provided the rugs. Barbara Tellalian is to be commended for the excellent Public Relations and Publicity this sale received.

On Saturday, December 1, 1984, the Annual Christmas Bazaar took place with Barbara Sahagian serving as Chairman. This, too, was a successful event and both Cultural and Johnson Halls were filled to capacity during the entire day. Delicious meals were served and holiday items and pastries were on sale. Two popular booths, Farmer's Market and Country Store, attracted the shoppers.

The Regional Meeting of New England Area Churches took place on Saturday, December 8, 1984, at the Our Saviour Armenian Church in Worcester. Our Church was indeed well-represented. Our Pastor was the Chairman for the day and Parish Council members and Diocesan Delegates attending were Nancy Kasarjian, Aetna Tashjian, Eugene Raphaelian, Gregory Krikorian, Daniel Dorian and Archie Kolligian. It should be noted here that Archie Kolligian and Stephen Panosian are members of the Regional Committee. John Soursourian was chosen Delegate.

On Sunday, December 16, 1984, following the Divine Liturgy, a Reception was tendered to Reverend Father Papken Maksoudian, Pastor Emeritus, on the occasion of his 35th Anniversary of his Consecration and ordination to the Holy Order of Priesthood. A large gathering of parishioners and friends were in attendance to celebrate this important event in the life of Der Papken who has dedicated his life not only to the Church but to the entire Armenian Community.

Also, on Sunday, December 16, 1984, a Khachakar was dedicated in the memory of Joseph Haroutunian in the presence of his immediate family. The Khachakar was given by the 1983 Parish Council and the impressive ceremony was held in the Parish Council office of the Church. This Khachakar now hangs on the wall of the Parish Council office for all to see.

Following an emotional sermon by our Pastor, a special plate was passed during the Divine Liturgy on Sunday, December 23, 1984, for the victims of the Ethiopian famine. A large sum of money was given by our parishioners which has been forwarded to the Diocese. Our contribution, together with other Churches' donations, will help alleviate the hunger and pestilence which exists in this unfortunate country. No doubt you have noticed the gleaming bronze doors of our Church. Mr. and Mrs. Alan Karchakian donated \$2,100.00 for the cleaning of the doors which were initially donated by Mr. and Mrs. Karchakian in memory of their son, Alan David.

The Pastor and Parish Council wish to express their thanks and appreciation to all the Church affiliated organizations and to our parishioners for their efforts and support in making the year 1984 such a successful year.
