



ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 1985

The Annual Parish Assembly of the Holy Trinity Armenian Apostolic Church of Greater Boston was held on Sunday afternoon, February 3, 1985, in the Cultural Hall at 1:00 p.m. Reverend Father Mampre A. Kouzouian, Pastor, presided and offered the opening prayer.

The Assembly was called to order by Stephen Panosian, Chairman of the Parish Council. The selection by the Nominating Committee of the Tivan for the day was announced by Helene Dorian, Chairman of this committee, as follows:

Chairman - Daniel K. Dorian Armenian Recording Secretary - Araxie Janjigian English Recording Secretary - Rose Minassian

There being no further nominations from the floor, the above-named were approved.

The Chairman for the Assembly then appointed John Soursourian to serve as Parliamentarian.

Mr. Dorian in addressing the Assembly stated if there were no objections from the floor, there would be no formal reading of the Annual Reports. However, questions could be addressed to the Chair. No objections were stated.

The Chairman then asked if there were any omissions or corrections noted in the 1984 Parish Assembly minutes. Diran Zahigian noted his name was listed under Diocesan Delegates erroneously and the name of John Soursourian was omitted. Margaret Atamian stated that at the 1984 Parish Assembly she had made a Motion which was seconded and approved to have sample ballots mailed prior to Parish Assemblies state the length of term of office. She noted this had not been done for this year's Assembly.

A motion was made and seconded that the 1984 Parish Assembly minutes be received after duly noting the aforementioned corrections. MOTION PASSED.

Helene Dorian, Chairman of the Nominating Committee, was called upon to present the slate as put forward by her committee. They are as follows:

Mrs. Dorian informed those present, nominations for each category would be accepted from the floor. There being none, a Motion was made and seconded to receive the selection of candidates by the Nominating Committee.
MOTION PASSED.

The chairman of the Assembly announced that since there were more than 50 dues paying members present which constitutes a quorum, this meeting was duly called to order.

A recess was declared to allow dues paying members to cast their votes.

Pastor's Annual Report for 1984:

The Reverend Father Mampre A. Kouzouian, Pastor, in addressing the Assembly stated since all members had received the published Annual Report, it would not be necessary to read his report in its entirety. However, if there were any questions, he would respond.

Father Mampre commented upon the following Pastoral activities: Church Services, Sacraments and Services, Counseling Services, Pastoral Visitations, Meetings, Cultural and Educational Projects, Youth Ministry, Important Events, Visit to Holy Etchmiadzin and Church Office. He extended his appreciation to Reverend Father Papken Maksoudian, Pastor Emeritus, and the Very Reverend Father Oshagan Minassian.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Pastor's Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Yearly Statement of the Parish Council (January 1, 1984 - December 31, 1984), Proposed Budget for 1985:

Barbara Sahagian, Treasurer of the Parish Council, was called upon to answer questions by parishioners.

Concern was expressed regarding insurance coverage of bank accounts in the name of our Church. Ms Sahagian explained no one account exceeds \$100,000.00, the maximum covered by bank insurance. Also, a portion of our monies was invested in Money Market accounts.

There being no further questions, the Chairman entertained a Motion to receive the Yearly Statement of the Parish Account (January 1, 1984 - December 31, 1984). A Motion was made and seconded. MOTION PASSED.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive 1985 Proposed Budget. MOTION PASSED.

Trust Fund:

George D. Hagopian, Treasurer of the Executive Committee of the Trust Fund, was asked to explain the Trust Fund. Mr. Hagopian stated next year marks the 10th year the Trust Fund has been in existence. Income from this fund cannot be used until after the 10th year.

Father Mampre informed the parishioners the Armenian Church Endowment Fund has been established by the Diocese and many of our parishioners have contributed to this fund and have requested the annual income form their contribution be allotted to our Church. He expressed his gratitude to those who have made gifts to our Trust Fund and the Armenian Church Endowment Fund.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Trust Fund Report. MOTION PASSED.

Women's Guild Annual Report:

Mr. Dorian stated our Women's Guilds are individual organizations and meet once a year at the Annual Diocesan Assembly. In 1971 an attempt was made to have a Central Office but this was not accompished. However, the Primate and Diocesan Council have expressed a desire to nationalize all the Women's Guilds and have them elect their own Central Council. The support of the Guild is important and necessary to address serious issues such as shortage of clergy; maintenance of St. Nersess Seminary in New Rochelle, New York; and plans for our retire priests.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Women's Guild Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Chelsea Women's Auxiliary Annual Report:

Father Mampre in addressing the Asembly noted the Chelsea Women's Auxiliary is a small group of dedicated women living in the Chelsea area who meet once a month combining luncheon and a meeting as a get-together. They also contribute financially and morally to our Church. They have often expressed a desire to disband but he has discouraged this as he feels these meetings are occasions that bring them together and they enjoy each other's company.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Chelsea Women's Auxiliary Report as received. MOTION PASSED.

Lynn, Salem, Peabody Women's Auxiliary Annual Report:

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Lynn, Salem, Peabody Auxiliary Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Trinity Men's Union Annual Report:

The Assembly was informed the Trinity Men's Union is planning a joint meeting with their brother organization of St. James Armenian Church in Watertown.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Trinity Men's Union Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Friends of Holy Trinity - 1000 Club Annual Report:

Barbara Sahagian, Treasurer, stated the highlight for 1984 of this organization was the September Dinner and Drawing. This event brought out a large attendance and for the first time in the history of the 1000 Club, all 1000 numbers were sold. She attributed this successful event to a special prize offered - a trip for 2 to Hawaii.

Ms Sahagian further stated this organization is now in the process of converting ticket sales on an annual or semi-annual basis which will bring about a 25% savings in stationery and postage. In reply to a question whether a Massachusetts State Tax is paid, Ms Sahagian replied there is a Lottery Tax which must be paid regardless of the type of sponsoring organization. Motion made to receive 1000 Club Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Holy Trinity Armenian Church Choir Annual Report:

The Pastor expressed his appreciation to the Deacons, Altar Servers, Organist and the Choir and its director, Father Oshagan, who every Sunday regardless of weather conditions participate in the Divine Liturgy. He announced to the Assembly that Norman Odabashian who served on the Altar of our Church isstudying at St. Nersess Seminary for the Priesthood.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Holy Trinity Armenian Church Choir Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Armenian School Annaul Report:

Araxie Janjigian in addressing the Assembly stated we are all aware of the importance of maintaining the Armenian School. Students are learning conversational Armenian and are being taught Armenian History. The Armenian School is beneficial to all of us, she stated.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Armenian School Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Sunday School Annual Report:

Father Mampre informed the Assembly that effective January 1, 1985 the Sharing Program will be continued on a once-a-month basis with students being asked to attend Sunday School every Sunday. This action was taken at the request of the parents. The Pastor will visit and participate in activities once every month.

Because they find a need to devote more time to their studies, the two Youth Directors of our Church, have asked to be relieved of their duties. They will, however, remain active in Church programs and Sunday School.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the Sunday School Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Trinity Couples Club Annual Report:

There being no comments or questions, a Motion was made and seconded to receive the Trinity Couples Club Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

A.C.Y.O.A. Seniors Annual Report:

Father Mampre stated a program for Armenian students in local colleges and universities initiated by Ken Maranian and Mark McKertick will continue since it has shown to be very successful for this age group.

A motion was made and seconded to receive the A.C.Y.O.A. Seniors Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

A.C.Y.O.A. Juniors Annual Report:

Father Mampre informed the Assembly he has asked Gregory Krikorian and James Kalustian to assist in planning activities for the A.C.Y.O.A. Juniors and he is grateful to both for their cooperation.

On Sunday, February 17, 1985, immediately following the Divine Liturgy, Poon Paregentan, a family fun day, sponsored by the Jujniors will take place. The Pastor asked those present to support this event and encourage our youth. He stressed the importance of parents' participation which will help in maintaining a healthy organization.

A Motion was made and seconded to receive the A.C.Y.O.A. Juniors Annual Report. MOTION PASSED.

Armenian Martyrs' Monument Committee:

The Chairman called upon Archie Kolligian who heads the Armenian Martyrs Monument Committee to address the Assembly.

Mr. Kolligian stated the committee has had several preliminary meetings and letters have been written to Armenian artists asking them what type of designs they recommend. Approximately 10 letters have been sent and three responses have been received.

He stated parishioners will be informed as soon as more information has been received. The committee is now studying a model which one of the artists has submitted.

In reply to a question where the memorial monument will be placed, Mr. Kolligian stated 2 or 3 locations have been suggested but a definite location has not been determined. A suggestion that artists other than Armenians be contacted was made and Mr. Kolligian stated the committee is looking into this. He stated the size of the monument would depend on its location. Regarding Building Codes, the Assembly was informed the committee has met with officials of the City of Cambridge and tentative approval has been given.

The cost of a Armenian Martyrs' Monument will be approximately \$100,000.00 and a parishioner echoed the opinion of most of those present when she added we should not count our pennies too closely when it comes to honoring our Martyrs.

Observing the 70th Anniversary of the Genocide:

The Pastor was invited to address the Assembly regarding plans to commemorate the 70th Anniversary of the Genocide.

He stated on February 23, 1985 there will be a Testimonial Banquet honoring Governor George Deukmejian of California in Washington, D.C. and asked all those present to attend this affair to honor "an offspring blossoming from the ashes". Other prominent Armenians and artists will participate in the program that evening and our parishioners were asked to join His Eminence Torkom Archbishop Manoogian, the Clergy of our Diocese and other prominent Armenians to honor Governor Deukmejian.

There will be other progrmas in April to honor the martyrs which will take place in New York and our community will be invited to participate.

Locally, on the Eve of Holy Thursday, April 4, 1985, twelve survivors will be selected for the Washing of the Feet ceremony in our Church. The Honorable George Keverian, Speaker of the House, will address the congregation.

On April 13, 1985, there will be a Symposium at the John F. Kennedy Building, Harvard University at which time different aspects of the Genocide will be discussed by a panel composed of prominent educators.

All New England Churches of our Diocese will participate in the Divine Liturgy at our Church on April 23, 1985. The Vicar General, the Very Reverend Father Baret Yeretzian, will officiate.

On April 26, 1985, together with the Jewish community, our Martyrs will be honored at the State House in Boston. Among the dignitaries invited are Gvoernor Michael Dukakis and Speaker of the House, George Keverian. Dr. Gregory Adamian, President of Bentley College, will be the guest speaker.

October is our Cultural Month and this year the theme for all acitivities will be the Rebirth of the Armenian Spirit.

The Diocesan Assembly:

The Chairman announced that this year the Diocesan Assembly will take place in Bayside, Long Island on May 5, 1985.

A parishioner commented that last year a special meeting was called by our Church to inform parishioners what had taken place at the 1984 Diocesan Assembly. She stated she found this very informative and recommended we have such meetings in the future.

Mr. Dorian stated this item will be placed on the agenda for the next Parish Council meeting and as suggested, we will have a meeting after this year's Diocesan Assembly.

Referring to this year's Annual Report, Page 2e, Margaret Atamian asked what action had been made on a Motion she had made and which was passed that a Diocesan Delegate should have been first a member of the Parish Council and served at least one term as a Trustee. (This motion was made and seconded at last year's Parish Assembly and passed.) The Chairman stated, as required, this Motion was submitted to the Proposal Committee for the 1984 Diocesan Assembly but did not pass.

The Chairman called upon Stephen Panosian, Chairman of the Parish Council, to address the Assembly on the Regionalization Program. Mr. Panosian stated the Primate and Diocesan Council have given their approval for Regionalization and the program has been started. The amount allocated by the Dioceses is \$20,000.00 and our Church has paid its share designated for this program.

On February 23, 1985 the Holy Trinity Armenian Church will be host to other New England Armenian Churches at a meeting of the Regionalization Committee. Mr. Panosian explained the Regionalization Program started with an Ad Hoc Committee and almost became a mandate from the Primate and Diocesan Council because the duties of the Diocese is so great and complex. In the near future a lay coordinator will be chosen.

The Chairman asked both secretaries to note that the Regionalization Report be placed on the agenda of future Parish Assemblies.

The Chairman of the Nominating Committee was asked to come forward and inform the Assembly of the election results. Mrs. Dorian stated 139 ballots were cast, one of which was voided.

He stated he would publicly like to express his appreciation to Council members whose terms have expired, the incumbent members and the newly elected Council members. Outgoing Parish Council members are Rose Minassian, whose 6 year term has expired, Gregory Krikorian and Richard Surabian. Incumbent members who were reelected ard: Nancy Kasarjian, Stephen Panosian and Robert Proodian. Father Mampre welcomed the newly elected members to the Parish Council who are Haig Agababian, James Kalustian and Mary Ann Soursourian. He personally thanked present members of the Council for their devotion to the Church, namely, Barbara Sahagian, Arthur Panosian, Bruce Haroutunion, Aetna Tashjian, and Harry Kaprelian. Father Mampre expressed his gratitude to Helene Dorian, Chairman of the Nominating Committee, and her committee for their capability. He stated he is proud of the Diocesan Delegates, one of whom is a member of the Diocesan Council.

In addressing the Assembly, Father Mampre extended his thanks to all the parishioners for their participation, hard work and financial contributions. He added that every time the parishioners have been called upon to serve the Church, they have done so without hesitation. In order to last as a Parish, he stated, we can do it only by our worshipping together. "I appeal to you. You all have made financial sacrifices to build the most beautiful Church and you are the ones who will give life to the Church", he told the parishioners and asked for their presence, support and prayer.

The Benediction was delivered by the Reverent Father Papken Maksoudian, Pastor Emeritus.

The 1985 Parish Assembly of the Holy Trinity Armenian Apostolic Church of Greater Boston adjourned at 4:15 p.m.

HOLY TRINITY ARMENIAN APOSTOLIC CHURCH PASTOR'S ANNUAL REPORT FOR 1985 REVEREND FATHER MAMPRE KOUZOUIAN

Dear Parishioners:

It is with great pleasure that I give an accounting to His Eminence, the Primate, and to our parishioners of my stewardship in this parish for the year 1985. The year 1985 culminates the Ninth Anniversary of my ministry amongst you. During 1985 we have worked together for the glory of God, for the spiritual growth of our people and for the edification of our Church. If during this year we had any successes or shortcomings, we wish to share that with you. I give thanks to Almighty God for giving me good health and the wisdom to serve His flock in the Holy Trinity Church of Greater Boston.

I wish to categorize my pastoral activities as follows:

I. Church Services

Church services were conducted every Sunday and on special occasions. Sermons were delivered in both languages. Sometimes services were conducted by the Pastor Emeritus, Father Papken Maksoudian. Occasionally sermons were also delivered by the choir director, Father Oshagan Minasian.

Here I wish to mention that, every Sunday, some of our altar servers, participated in the Church Services from the very beginning until the end. In appreciation of their devotion to our Church, it is my intention to appeal to His Eminence, the Primate, to elevate the following altar servers to the rank of sub-diaconate during 1986. They are Robert Nahabedian, Alexan Kouzouian, Gary Alexander, and Edward Marootian.

During 1985, the following clergy have conducted Services in our Church, delivered sermons or simply visited our Church:

- On May 26, Father Yeghishe Sarkissian, Abbott of the Monastery of Keghart, Armenia, celebrated the Divine Liturgy and delivered the sermon. On that occasion, Anita Terzian, a talented opera star, was our guest soloist. During that week we also received a visitation from Father Kourken Mouradian, the Abbott of the Monastery of Khorvirab, Armenia.
- On June 16, Father's Day, Bishop Nersess Bozabalian, Chancellor of the Mother See of Holy Etchmiadzin, celebrated and delivered the sermon. A reception for His Grace was held following Church Services. On that day, we also performed Annual Requieum Service for the deceased benefactors and parishioners of our Church. Bishop Bozabalian was visiting Boston to participate at an Orthodox Church Conference sponsored by the World Council of Churches.

- On June 23, Father Mesrob Benlian was our guest celebrant. Father Mesrob is the pastor of the Armenian Church of Sophia, Bulgaria. He was visiting the U.S. during his annual vacational.
- On September 15, Bishop Papken Varjabedian, Legate of the Diocese in Washington, D.C., presided at Church Services.
- On October 22, Bishop Avak Asadorian of Bagdad, Iraq, visited our Church.
- On November 6, Very Reverend Father Daron Jeredjian of Nice, France, and Bishop Vasken Keshishian of Canada visited our Church.

On Christmas and Easter Eves, I conducted Services and administed Holy Communion to the children of our parish.

On Vartanantz Day, jointly with St. James, we conducted Badarak in our Church.

During Lent, every Wednesday and Friday, we had Lenten Services.

According to the traditions of our Church, during Holy Week we conducted services.

On Holy Thursday, to commemorate the 70th Anniversary of the Genocide of our people, I washed the feet of twelve survivors.

On April 24, a joint service was held at St. James Armenian Church followed by a Requieum Services at the foot of the Martyrs Monument.

On Thursday, May 16, to celebrate the Ascension of our Lord, the Divine Liturgy was celebrated. The members of the Senior Womens Guild received Holy Communion followed by a dinner and traditional celebration of Ascension.

On June 22, I celebrated at the Armenian Church of Cape Cod.

On Sept. 15, we conducted "Family Reunion Day" Service. The purpose of this service is to encourage the faithful to participate in our church services, and start a new activities season around the church. On this day, a complimentary brunch was served to the faithful which was offered by the Trustee of the Jack Kolligian Foundation.

On November 24, a Thanksgiving Family Service and on December 23, a Christmas Family Service and carolling, took place in our Church.

I wish to take this opportunity to emphasize the spiritual benefits of attending Church Services and receiving spiritual nourishment. If we are to survive as a Christian Church and community, it is essential that we be a part of a worshipping community.

I am happy to inform you that since September of 1985, there has been an increase in attendance. I pray that God will move us to be a part of the worshipping congregation of our Church.

II. Sacraments and Services

During 1985 the following sacraments and services were performed in our Church:

Baptisms = 18 Confirmations = 4 Engagements = 2
Weddings = 20 Funerals = 35

During many of these occasions, I have been with the families of the bereaved to console them and counsel them, and partake in their grief or joy.

III. Counselling Services

On 42 different occasions, I conducted counselling sessions with individuals who had personal problems and families who were facing family crises. I conducted premarital counselling with young people who were preparing to receive the sacrament of Holy Matrimony. On 17 different occasions, I conducted wedding rehearsals. During these rehearsals I explain to the young couples the different symbolism in the wedding ceremony. Pre-confirmation counselling with adults has also been conducted. The pastor is available to our parishioners at all times to advise and counsel them whenever they are facing a crisis.

IV. Pastoral Visitations

Three hundred pastoral visitations were made during 1985. These visitations were made to homes of our parishioners, to hospitals, and to the Armenian and non-Armenian Nursing Homes. For the purpose of blessing graves and conducting funeral services, on many occasions I have also visited cemeteries with parishioners.

Through the use of the telephone, the pastor has reached out to the members of our community and particularly to those who are elderly, sick at home, or shut-ins. I have shown to them the concern of the Church in their welfare. I have done the same prior to the high holidays congratulating them on these occasions. These phone calls and visitations are highly appreciated by them.

V. Meetings

During 1985 I participated and presided over 347 meetings. Of these meetings, 308 have been with parish-affiliated organizations, their executive bodies, standing committees or with individuals. The remaining 39 have been on the Diocesan level. From April 30 through May 1st, I have participated in the Annual Clergymen's Conference in Long Island, New York; from May 2 through 5, I have participated in the Annual Diocesan Assembly together with our delegates at the Holy Martyr's Armenian Church of Long Island. As Chairman of the Diocesan Council, I took an active role in this assembly. During the past four years, I had the distinct honor and privilege to serve as Chairman of the Diocesan Council, the highese executive body of our Church.

In order to devote time to my parish work, on May 4, at the conclusion of my speech at the Assembly Banquet, I informed the delegates that after serving four years as Chairman, I would step aside from that office so that others may continue serving in the same capacity. On May 5 during the Assembly Divine Liturgy, I delivered the sermon of the day.

Until last May I chaired the monthly Diocesan Council Meetings and the Regional Meetings of our Diocese. I have continued serving as a member of the Unity Committee of our Diocese. During the ACYOA Sports Weekend I participated at the ACYOA Assembly with our delegate. During the summer on three different occasions I took part in the Outreach Committee Dialogue with parishioners.

On February 23, I took part at the gathering of survivors of the genocide and the testimonial banquet held in Washington, D.C. to honor the Governor of California.

On April 23, we had a meeting of the clergy of New England hosted by the Holy Cross Church of Lawrence.

On June 4, I participated at a conference of Armenian representatives from the Greater Boston area, with the representatives from the Boston Globe, to discuss the relationship of this newspaper with the Armenian community.

On June 6, we had a special Parish Assembly in order that our delegates may inform our parishioners of the outcome of the Annual Diocesan Assembly.

On June 27, representatives of our parish and the pastor had a meeting with some of our neighbors to discuss some of the problems that were of mutual concern to all.

On December 14 our parish hosted the Diocesan Regional Conference.

In addition to the above, I have represented our parish at important church functions sponsored by the different Armenian churches of New England.

VI. Cultural and Educational

Thanks to the efforts of the Cultural Committee, with the financial support of our Parish Council and parishioners, during the entire month of October we had provided outstanding cultural programs for our parishioners and neighbors. These programs may be reviewed in the Cultural Committee's report elsewhere in this booklet. The Christmas concerts held at the Holy Trinity Church have now become a traditional event. On December 15, His Eminence, the Primate of our Diocese presided and spoke. On this occasion, he also presented an Encyclical and Medal of His Holiness Vazken I, Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians to the Honorable George Keverian, Speaker of the House of Massachusetts.

On December 22nd, a commemorative program took place in our Cultural Center dedicated to the memory of Gomidas Vartabed. This was held on the 50th Anniversary of the demise of the late venerable Gomitas Vartabed.

I have also utilized the monthly meetings of our church-affiliated organizations and other gatherings to speak on different subjects enlightening our parishioners. We have utilized the monthly publication of our parish, the "Dajar", as a source of information and education. We have also encouraged and spread amongst our parishioners, religious and educational publications of our Diocese.

Here I wish to express my concern and appeal to our parishioners to take an active interest and role in the Armenian and Sunday Schools where our children learn the Christian faith of our forefathers and culture. In both schools we can do better when there is more cooperation from our parents. Once again we appeal to them to be interested in the welfare of the Christian and Armenian education of their children and our schools. Since September 1985, the enrollment and attendance is better but can certainly increase. I wish to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to the dedicated teachers and staff of both the Armenian and Sunday Schools. May God bless them and reward them.

VII. Youth Ministry

Despite our efforts to find a youth director to be in charge of the youth minstry, our efforts did not bear fruit. We need an individual to be in charge of this department and oversee the Christian education of our Church School. We have not given up hope and shall continue our efforts to find one. Presently James Kalustian is helping our youth during their meetings and functions. Thanks to his efforts and the cooperation of the Chairman of the ACYOA, Srs., on different occasions the young people studying in colleges around the Greater Boston area get-together in Shahe Hall for an Armenian meal and to socialize. This useful program began with the efforts of Mark McKertich and Kenny Maranian. We also wish to thank Rose Aznavorian and Tana Onanian for overseeing the smooth operation of the Sunday School. We express our gratitude to all our dedicated teachers and to the individuals who assist our youth.

VIII. 70th Anniversary

1985 marked the 70th Anniversary of the 1915 Genocide of the Armenian people. Important commemorative events took place all over the world.

Holy Trinity Church marked this commemorative year with the following services and events.

- a. On March 31, following the Palm Sunday Banquet, members of the ACYOA planted a tree in the Church yard dedicated to the memory of the martyrs.
- b. On April 4, Holy Thursday, during the Washing of the Feet Services, the pastor washed the feet of twelve survivors including Mr. Krikor Derderian of Methuen, one of the oldest survivors of this tragic event. Our guest speaker on this day was the Honorable George Keverian, Speaker of the House of Massachusetts. An impressive television and news media coverage was given to this event. The Associated Press had sent pictures of the Washing of the Feet nationwide.

- c. On April 13 at the Kennedy Building of Harvard University, a Symposium was held on the Genocide with the participation of Armenian and non-Armenian scholars.
- d. On April 23, the New England Armenian Churches joined us at the Divine Liturgy celebrated in our Church by the Vicar of the New England area and with the participation of the clergy, choir members and the faithful. Our guest speaker was His Eminence Archbishop Bernard Law of the Archdiocese of Boston. We also had the survivors of the Genocide participate during the Requiem Service. The news media, through television and newspapers, gave wide coverage. They also interviewed the pastor and some survivors.
- e. On April 24th, a Memorial Concert and Program took place in our Church with the participation of the Erevan Chorus and survivors.
- f. On April 26th, a joint commemorative program with the Jewish community of Greater Boston was held at the State House. Dr. Gregory Adamian, President of Bently College, spoke on behalf of the Armenian people. Governor Michael Dukakis, Archbishop Bernard Law, Speaker George Keverian and other dignitaries participated.
- g. On April 28th, we journeyed to our national Cathedral in New York with a busload of survivors to take part in the gathering of the survivors. We took part in the Divine Liturgy, Hokejash, and commemorative program in the Cathedral. As Chairman of the Diocesan Council, I delivered an address in the Cathedral.

IV. Important Events

- a. As Armenians and members of the Holy Trinity Church, we were proud that a son of one of our parishioners was elected Speaker of the House of Representatives of our Commonwealth. The Honorable George Keverian brings credit to all Armenians. To celebrate this important event, I brought together individuals from the Armenian community to discuss with them and plan a testimonial honoring the new Speaker. I am delighted that Armenians of Greater Boston responded favorable, and on May 25th a Banquet was tendered in Boston honoring George Keverial. Over 1200 Armenians were present. I, as the pastor of the Keverian family, introduced the guest of honor to the audience.
- b. On September 11, I was present in our Church Hall at a reception given in honor of the Honorable Dikran Bogosian who was appointed as the United States Ambassador to Niger. He is the son of Arshalooys Bogosian.
- c. On September 29, our parish celebrated the 35th Anniversary of the Ordination of Father Papken Maksoudian, our Pastor Emeritus. Father Papken celebrated the Divine Liturgy and delivered the sermon on that occasion. Over 500 parishioners had gathered in our Cultural Center for the Testimonial Banquet honoring Father Papken. On this occasion, the community expressed its appreciation and gratitude for his devoted services to the Holy Trinity Church and the Armenian people. A booklet was printed on that occasion and distributed to the parishioners. The Chairman of the 35th Anniversary Committee was John Soursourian, one of our delegates to whom we express our gratitude.

d. On October 20th, during our Anniversary Banquet, we honored Charles Zeytoonjian as "Man of the Year."

X. Solicitations

During the year, I have also solicited funds for our parish and religious vessels for our Church.

a. I am grateful to parishioners who have contributed monetarily to the Holy Trinity Trust Fund and to the general operating expenses of our Church. Nine years ago the Holy Trinity Trust Fund had only \$17,622. today that sum has passed the \$700,000 mark.

The annual operating budget of our Church was \$127,222 in 1976; today it has passed \$400,000. We owe this to the generosity and the kindness of our people. We thank all the workers and donors.

- b. We are glad that during the year we have secured different useful religious vessels for our Church, i.e., hand cross, chalice, and a pastoral staff. We thank the kind donors.
- c. We have also encouraged parishioners to contribute to the Armenian Church Endowment Fund of our Diocese, interest being shared by the Diocese and our Church. We thank the generous donors.

XI. Church Office

We have kept our office open from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Mondays through Fridays. The pastor, pastor emeritus, our secretary Rose Mamishian, and bookeeper Harvinder Jassal handle the office work. A group of parishioners and friends often volunteer their services to the office to whom we express our gratitude. I would like to specifically express my appreciation to our Church secretary Rose Mamishian, for her dedication, and to our volunteers.

XII. Appreciation

My appreciation is extended to our pastor emeritus, Reverend Father Papken Maksoudian, for his help in carrying on my ministry in our parish. Also to Father Oshagan Minasian for his services. I would like to express my appreciation to the Chairman of our Parish Council, Stephen Panosian, and the members of the Parish Council for their dedication and leadership.

I thank all our parishioners for their prayers, and support, and their contributions made to our Church. May God reward you all with his blessings.

For the Holy Trinity Church, 1985 was a year of progress, marked by significant improvements to our facilities and successes by our social and cultural organizations.

In an attempt to upgrade the capabilities of our Church office and to add to the comfort and pleasure of our parishioners, the Parish Council made several major acquisitions in 1985. Noteworthy among them were the following: a 3M wireless security system for the Church sanctuary; a sound system for the Cultural Hall equipped with receiver, casette, and wireless microphone; an upright freezer; four hundred (400) cushioned stackable chairs for the Cultural Hall; an electric Armenian typewriter; and a Canon copier for the Church office.

In addition to the above acquisitions, the maintenance committee actively tended to the physical upkeep of our buildings and grounds. Among the many items completed were the following: new lighting for the Sunday School and Cultural Hall foyer; completion of the repair of the flatbed roofs; removal of many oversized trees and shrubs from the Church grounds; considerable masonry work on the exterior of the Church and Shahe Hall; and the replacement of the ramp to Shahe Hall.

In 1985, the Parish Council again sponsored a number of successful cultural and social events. The annual Church Picnic, chaired by Bruce Haroutunian, was held on Sunday, September 8th. On Sunday, September 29th, Father Paken Maksoudian was honored on the occasion of the 35th Anniversary of his consecration and ordination to the Holy Order of Priesthood. John Soursourian chaired the event.

October was cultural month and the cultural committee arranged for a very interesting and informative array of Armenian speakers and artists. Sunday, October 20th was Stewardship Sunday and the 24th Anniversary of the consecration of our Church. Charles Zeytoonjian was honored as Man of the Year at

the Annual Banquet, chaired this year by Eugene Raphaelian. The Rug Sale was expanded to five (5) days this year, October 20-21 and November 1-3. General Vahan Vartanian chaired the organizing committee.

The annual Church Bazaar took place on Saturday, December 7th and was co-chaired by Cheryl Panjian and Diran Zahigian. The annual Christmas Conert was rendered by Father Oshagan Minassian and the Erevan Choral Society on Sunday, December 15th. On Sunday, December 22nd, a program was offered in the Cultural Center commemorating the 50th Anniversary of Gomidas Vartabed.

Negotiations on our contract with the Apple School were completed. The contract currently extends through August of 1986.

The Parish Council again expressed its commitment to the cultural education of the children of the parish by sponsoring deserving Sunday School and Armenian School students for Camp Vartan and the St. Nersess Summer Studies Conferences. The Council has also decided to underwrite the publication costs of one volume of the new Diocesan Sunday School Curriculum. This is the first Sunday School curriculum specifically written and tested for use in the Sunday Schools of our Diocese.

Funds were allocated to the parish's monument committee which is working toward the erection of a monument on our Church grounds in memory of the victims of the Armenain Genocide. Special collections were made during the Divine Liturgy to assist the victims of the Mexican earthquake and the Colombian flood.

On Saturday, December 14th, our parish hosted the annual Diocesan Regional Meeting. Looking to the future, Holy Trinity will also host the annual Diocesan Assembly in May of 1988. In anticipation of this event, a committee chaired by Nancy Kasarjian is being organized to address preliminary preparations. Arthur Panosian is chairing the Cultural Hall Project Committee which has ben recently organized to conduct a feasability study into potential improvements that may be made to the Cultural Center. The Council's desire is to improve the rentability of the Cultural Hall and more importantly its immediate use by our parishioners.

The Pastor and Parish Council wish to express our thanks to the parishioners and to all of the Church affiliated organizations for their continued efforts and support.
