Dear Mr. Dadourian:

A Special Parish Assembly of the Holy Trinity Armenian Church of Cambridge, MA, was held on September 18, 1994, during which two proposals were presented. The first proposal was a plan to renovate the exterior of the parish rectory, with a provision that the cost of the project not exceed \$300,000. The second proposal concerns the sale of two parcels of land bequeathed to the parish, one in Tewksbury, MA, and one in Volusia County, Florida. Both proposals were presented to the 91 members present at the meeting. An affirmative vote of 72 was received for the renovation and 62 and 70 votes were respectfully received for the two parcels of land.

The Diocesan Council at their October 21st meeting approved the above requests (see enclosures) and now presents it to the Board of Trustees for final ratification.

In accordance with Article 75, sec. C. the members of the Board of Trustees shall have the duty to:

"Sell, convey, lease, <u>improve</u>. exchange...property belonging to the Diocese of the Armenian Church, in such a manner and upon such terms to be determined by the Diocesan Council..."

Please indicate your position regarding the Diocesan Council's decision and return the enclosed form to our office so that we may notify the parish.
