

Annual report of the Sunday School of the Holy Ascension
Armenian Church for the year of 1975

In January of 1975 there were approximately forty-two (42) students and seven (7) teachers who met in two (2) classrooms from 10:45 AM until 12 noon.

Beginning in October we enrolled twenty-eight (28) students with five (5) full time and two (2) part time teachers in the same facilities.

The average attendance throughout the year has run from five (5) to thirty (30) students each Sunday.

In addition to regular weekly classes we have had a Christmas program and party, bake sale and graduation exercises in which five (5) students received diplomas. Since reconvening in September there has been a Halloween party, lectures in English by Der Heyr, movies, a visit to the Russian Church and a Christmas Candlelight service.

On December 31, 1974 the Sunday School bank balance was \$256.39. Since then a total of \$691.73 has been deposited and \$85.26 withdrawn leaving a balance on hand of \$862.86 as of December 31, 1975.
