PASTOR'S REPORT TO THE ANNUAL ASSEMBLY, FEBRUARY 20, 1972

? Dear Parishioners:

By the grace of God and with the cooperation of our church members, we have completed another successful year. In church life, success is measured by the awareness of its members of their spiritual needs. All of us are servants of the Church and have the duty in this parish of preserving our Christian faith and our national culture. The programs and activities indicate that the path is set, that we must pass on our religious and ethnic culture to our younger generation.

It gives us great pleasure as Pastor to report to this assembly our spiritual and administrative accomplishments of the past year, 1971. Of course, you must remember that we were convalescing from a heart attack for three months.

Sacramental activities

During the past year we have offered the Divine Liturgy every Sunday, taking great effort to see that the services began on time. We also had special Divine Liturgy on the eve of Armenian Christmas and Easter; and also on the eve of the Fortieth Anniversary celebration Divine Liturgy was offered by His Eminence, Archbishop Torkom Manoogian. Also, three evening services were held on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday during the Easter season. We have delivered sermons each Sunday, fulfilling and strengthening the spiritual needs of our faithful. We have performed four baptisms and confirmations, three marriages, and four funeral services.

Visitations

During the past year, we have visited the sick and elderly and those who were in mourning to offer them spiritual comfort. We visited parishioners hospitalized in Bridgeport, Newtown, New Haven and Norwalk. We would like our members to keep in mind that we have no way of knowing when one enters the hospital. Each member should inform us when he anticipates being admitted to the hospital. During 1971 we have made over seventy-five hospital and sympathy visits. We have visited about one hundred and fifty homes either for home blessing or pastoral visitation. We have had over thirty premarital counselling consultations with four couples who were preparing for marriage in our Bridgeport church. We tried to reach every individual in spiritual need in every way we knew.

Choir and Altar

We would like to express our most sincere and heartfelt gratitude to the people who work with us throughout the year: to Deacon Vartan Stambolian; to Choirmaster, Mrs. Keghan Stambolian; to Organist, Mrs. Virginia Kalfaian; to my son, George Kalfayan, for his faithful service. We have attended the Diocesan Assembly at Montreal, Canada, with Dr. James Etmekjian, the Diocesan Delegate, during the first weekend in May, 1971, and have submitted our report to the Parish Council.

Armenian School

During the past year, we have continued to conduct the Armenian school at Trumbull High School until May, and are planning to continue to teach as soon as we regain or complete strength. We thank the Shakeh Varjaran members for their assistance. Youth Group
