PLEDGE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Pledge Committee for 1972 came into existence at the special Parish Assembly Meeting which was held on June 28. 1971/ The members of this committee are:

Mr. Vahe Derounian Mrs. Theresa Harabedian Mr. Andrew Taraian Mr. Vartan Umaner.

Several meetings were held, and it was decided with the consent of the Parish Council that a census, along with the pledges and dues be taken also; so that a telephone directory be printed. The following steps were taken:

- 1. The area constituting this parish be divided into four sections. Each pledge committee member was given an area, and together with a Parish Council member was to visit each family personally and explain the pledge system. A list of names for each area was given to each pledge committee member.
- 2. A form was printed on which one side is the pledge application and on the other, the census and telephone information.
- 3. A booklet entitled "Church Manners" was to be presented to each family visited as a gift from the Pledge Committee.

Three flyers, along with an article in the Pari Loor were mailed to all Armenians covering a radius of 50 miles East as well as West, explaining the plans of the Pledge Committee. The following pledge committee members were to cover these areas:

New Haven County----Mrs. Theresa Harabedian Stratford & Bridgeport----Mr. Vartan Umaner Fairfield & Trumbull----Mr. Andrew Taraian Norwalk & parts West as far as Stamford---Mr. Vahe Derounian

Mr. Derounian, because of his move to California, has since resigned from the committee.
