The 1978-1979 Sunday School year began with registration on Sept 23 with the bulk of it occuring on the 30th. Some 23 pupils enrolled at that time with school ages ranges from pre-kindergarten to junior high. At that point in time Miss Karen Misakian had volunteered to teach.
