
At our Annual Parish Assembly, which took place on Sun. Feb. 2, 1992, a resolution was passed unanimously regarding the shipment of the 50,000 pounds of remaining clothing collected for the refugees in Armenia.

The Assembly wish to convey their concerns and urge you to ship the clothes by plane immediately. The feeling was that the cost should not be an issue.

It was obvious to our parishioners that the need for the clothing is immediate in Armenia, as the severe cold has already reached our refugees. We are sure you equally share our concerns, although we understand the reasons behind Mr. Stamoltzian's request, the Assembly have come through with the original request of the Diocese which was to collect clothing for our people and we feel this request should be followed through.
