Reverend Nalbandian, Parish Council members, and parishioners, I want to thank you for the opportunity to serve you. For me, this year has been one of growth and challenges. I've had to develop new delegating and organizational skills. Yet, throughout the year you have been encouraging, helpful and understanding.

Yet there is much more to do to build our church financially and spiritually. Our Der Hyre needs the security and financial freedom to be able to spend more time in building up the faith of his congregation, instead of concentrating his time in helping us stay financially solvent. How do we solve this problem? Perhaps a miracle...in the meantime, we must all work together to accomplish this goal.

Finally, I want you to know that I'm proud to be part of this wonderful group and encourage you and our young people to get involved in serving our Holy Ascension Armenian Church.
